AN ORDINANCE BY COUNCILMEMBERS KEISHA LANCE BOTTOMS AND ALEX WAN ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS REGARDING THE CITY OF ATLANTA'S JUDICIAL AGENCY FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE JUDICIAL AGENCY 2015 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET SHOULD CONDITIONS NOT BE MET BY OCTOBER 1, 2014; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") adopted the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget ("FY20 15") on June 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City's Judicial Agency budget for FY2015 is \$12,833,513 which represents an increase of \$3,916,106 from FY2014; and

WHEREAS, according to the Judicial Agency the increase was needed to fund 44 additional positions as well as to operate the Municipal Court five days per week; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Atlanta City Council that each Municipal Court judge shall preside over a regularly scheduled calendar at least five days per week and that the Judicial Agency shall have filled at least fifty (50) percent of newly created positions by October 1, 2014 (collectively the "Conditions"); and

WHEREAS, if the Conditions are not met by October 1, 2014, the Judicial Agency 2015 Fiscal Year Budget shall be amended and reduced by 75 percent.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS; as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Judicial Agencies shall have filled 50 percent of the positions created in the FY2015 Budget by October 1, 2014.

SECTION 2: That each Municipal Court judge shall preside over a regularly scheduled calendar at least five days per week by October 1, 2014.

SECTION 3: That if the Conditions have not been met by October 1, 2014, the FY2015 Judicial Agency Budget increase of \$3,916,106 shall be amended and reduced by 75 percent as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 4: That any funds reduced from the Judicial Agency FY2015 Budget shall be credited to account 1001.200101.599901, the Non Departmental Budgeted Reserves.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances that conflict with this ordinance shall be waived to the extent of the conflict only.



WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") adopted the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget ("FY2015") on June 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City's Judicial Agency budget for FY2015 is \$12,833,513 which represents an increase of \$3,916,106 from FY2014; and

SECTION 4: That any funds reduced from the Judicial Agency FY2015 Budget shall be credited to account 1001.200101.599901, the Non Departmental Budgeted Reserves.
