MARTIN AND ANDRE DICKENS TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 ("ADMINISTRATION"), ARTICLE XVI ("BOARDS, COUNCILS, COMMISSIONS, AND AUTHORITIES), DIVISION 9 ("YOUTH COMMISSION"), SECTION 2-5052 OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REVISE THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE ATLANTA YOUTH COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 95-0-1193, adopted by the Atlanta City Council on November 6, 1995 and approved by the Mayor on November 15, 1995 without signature by operation of law created the Atlanta Youth Commission; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the Governing Board shall not exceed fifteen¹⁵ members, serving a term of six (6) years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, which then had a total number nineteen (19) councilmembers appointed seven (7) members to the Governing Board from the paired council districts and their at -large member; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now has a total of fifteen (15) councilmembers and the selection of appointees by the Council should be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Section 2-5052 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

The Governing Board shall be composed of residents of the City of Atlanta, with a total membership not to exceed fifteen (15) members to serve a term of two (2) years. They shall be selected as follows:

(a) Six (6) members appointed by the Mayor with two of these being the Chief of Police or his/her designee, the Commissioner of the Department of Parks & Recreation or his/her designee, and two (2) youth members selected from nominees submitted by the Superintendent of the Atlanta Public Schools;

(b) Seven (7) members appointed by the City Council, two (2) from the paired Council

Districts and their At-Large Councilmember (i.e. Districts 1, 2, 3,4, and Post 1 AtLarge) and one (1) by the Council President;

(c) Two (2) members appointed by the Atlanta Public Schools.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be repealed for the purpose of this ordinance only.
