A RESOLUTION BY COUNCIL MEMBER NATALYN M. ARCHIBONG AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AMENDMENT AGREEMENT NUMBER 2 WITH WRIGHT-BROWN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., FOR FC-5569, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$64,000.00); WITH ALL CONTRACTED WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, DEPARTMENT, ORGANIZATION AND ACCOUNT NUMBER LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") did solicit Bids for Contract Number FC-5569, Professional Services for Installation of Traffic Signals, on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 12-R-0592 on May 21, 2012, and the same was approved per City Charter Section 2-403 on May 30, 2012 which authorized the Agreement for FC-5569 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the base term of the Contract was for a period of one (1) year with two (2) one (1) year renewal options at the sole discretion of the City effective August 29, 2012 through August 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer authorized a 90-day extension of the Contract on August 5, 2013 giving a new expiration date of November 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 13-R-3527 on September 3, 2013 and the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on September 12, 2013 which allowed the Department of Public Works to enter into Renewal Agreement Number 1 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc. effective November 26, 2013 through November 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Ordinance 13-O-1258 on September 16, 2013 and the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on September 25, 2013 which transferred \$64,000.00 from the District 5 Councilmembers Carry-Forward account into the Department of Public Works for the installation of digital speed limit signs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to enter into Amendment Agreement Number 2 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc., for the installation of digital speed limit signs in District 5 in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$64,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc. has performed the contracted services satisfactorily; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend Amendment Agreement Number 2 for FC-5569, Professional Services for Installation of Traffic Signals.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into Amendment Agreement Number 1 for FC-5569, with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc. for the installation of digital speed limit signs in District 5 in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$64,000.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from the listed Fund Department Organization and Account Number: 1001 (General Fund) 130304 (DPW Traffic Signals) 5212001 (Consulting/Professional Services) 4270000 (Traffic Engineering).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Procurement Officer is directed to assist the City Attorney in the preparation of the appropriate Agreement for execution by the Mayor.

AND FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agreement will not become binding upon the City, and the City will incur no liability under it until the Agreement has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc.
