A RESOLUTION BY FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RIGHT OF WAY MOWING AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PROPERTY UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND TO SIMULTANEOUSLY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ATLANTA DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO ASSUME ALL CITY OF ATLANTA OBLIGATIONS SET FOR IN THE RIGHT OF WAY MOWING AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips within Georgia Department of Transportation ("GDOT") rights of ways must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") seeks to beautify and improve various rights of way by landscaping within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to authorize the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District to apply for a Gateway Grant from GDOT, and if awarded, to enter into a Mowing and Maintenance Agreement between the City and the Georgia Department of Transportation, as GDOT will not enter into agreements with non-public entities.

WHEREAS, upon the award of Gateway Grant funds from GDOT, the City shall simultaneously transfer all responsibility of the Mowing and Maintenance Agreement to ADID.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA that the Mayor may authorize the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District to apply for a Gateway Grant with the Georgia Department of Transportation. Upon award of the grant, the City of Atlanta shall enter into a Mowing and Maintenance Agreement with the Georgia Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to simultaneously execute an Agreement with the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District to transfer all responsibilities under the Mowing and Maintenance Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare and appropriate Agreement to be executed by the Mayor and to send copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Agreement will not become binding on the City and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney and delivered to Georgia Department of Transportation and the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District.

Upon award of the grant, the City of Atlanta shall enter into a Mowing and Maintenance Agreement with the Georgia Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to simultaneously execute an Agreement with the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District to transfer all responsibilities under the Mowing and Maintenance Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare and appropriate Agreement to be executed by the Mayor and to send copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Agreement will not become binding on the City and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney and delivered to Georgia Department of Transportation and the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District.
