A RESOLUTION BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF A NISSAN LEAF, FROM THE ATLANTA POLICE FOUNDATION (“FOUNDATION”), TO BE USED AS A PATROL CAR BY THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT (“DEPARTMENT”); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Belt Line’s dedicated police unit, the PATH Force, has determined the need for at least one motorized vehicle for use on the Atlanta Belt Line; and

WHEREAS, the PATH Force has specified that the desired motorized vehicle should be small, in order to maneuver on the Atlanta Belt Line, and create minimal disruption to the many pedestrians, cyclists, and other traffic, and have asked that the vehicle be electric powered; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Power Company has expressed the desire to repaint and prepare an electric powered 2013 Nissan Leaf, VIN# 1N4AZ0CP0DC422797 (“Nissan Leaf”) as an official Atlanta Police patrol car and donate it to the City of Atlanta, Georgia (“City”), for use on the Atlanta Belt Line by the PATH Force, at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the PATH Force, and the Belt Line, Inc. have both expressed their approval of assigning a Nissan Leaf to the PATH Force, for use on the Atlanta Belt Line; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Police Foundation accepted the Nissan Leaf from Georgia Power as a donation, and desires to subsequently turn the Nissan Leaf over to the Atlanta Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to accept the donation of an electric powered 2013 Nissan Leaf, VIN# 1N4AZ0CP0DC422797 (“Nissan Leaf”), on behalf of the Atlanta Police Department, to be used as an official Atlanta Police patrol car.

Section 2: That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived for purposes of this resolution only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
