

WHEREAS, the Community Improvement Association (“CIA”) is 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated watershed preservation, environmental remediation, water conservation, flood control and other water measures in low wealth, distressed Atlanta neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Proctor Creek is a Metro Atlanta watershed located throughout Council Districts 3, 4 and 9; and

WHEREAS, CIA applied for and was awarded a Hercules Community mini-Grant from the Emory Hercules Environmental Health Research Center at Emory University (“Emory”) in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Emory grant is to provide CIA funding so that it may conduct research, promote community awareness of local environmental health concerns and collect data; and

WHEREAS, the Proctor Creek Stewardship Council (“PCSC”) and the West Atlanta Watershed Alliance (“WAWA”) are working collaboratively with CIA under the Emory grant to increase scientific literacy and research capacity of Proctor Creek watershed residents through outreach, training, education and research, identify adverse environmental and public health hazards and engage community involvement and inform residents of watershed findings, restoration, community revitalization and policy solutions (the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta’s Department of Watershed Management also supports CIA’s efforts in the Proctor Creek watershed and has agreed to donate water testing kits and other supplies to CIA in furtherance of the Program; and

WHEREAS, CIA has requested a matching grant of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) from Councilmembers Ivory Lee Young, Cleta Winslow and Felicia Moore (collectively the “Councilmembers”) to further CIA’s work under the Emory grant and the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Code of Ordinances Charter Section 6-306 Appropriations for charitable purposes specifically authorizes donations by the City to organizations for charitable purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Councilmembers desire to award a matching grant to CIA in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) in support of CIA's work in the Proctor Creek watershed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Councilmembers, on behalf of the City are hereby authorized to award a matching grant to CIA in the amount of Two Thousand Five Dollars (\$2,500.00) to be used in conjunction with the Emory grant in furtherance of the Program.
