WHEREAS, Chastain Park located in Atlanta, Georgia, (the "Park"), is a City of Atlanta ("City") regional park serving the needs of a large geographic area, offering several picnic structures, a playground, baseball fields and other amenities; and

WHEREAS, the Chastain Park Conservancy ("CPC") is a 501(c)(3) dedicated to the preservation of the Park and desires to donate architectural, design and construction services for the purpose of designing a trail and bridge along Powers Ferry Road in the Park as described in the 2003 Chastain Park Master Plan (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, CPC has partnered with the PATH Foundation, Inc., ("PATH"), a Georgia 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose business is to design, construct, and maintain trails on behalf of public agencies with approximately fifteen years of experience building trails in the City and surrounding communities, and is dedicated to providing expertise in the planning and implementation of trail system projects and locating private funding to reduce or eliminate the cost to the City and its taxpayers to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated Project cost is Two Million Dollars and CPC and PATH intend to contribute half the cost of the Project in the amount of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 12-0-0013 adopted by Council on February 6, 2012 and approved by the Mayor on February 20, 2012 the City and CPC entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 13-R-3275 adopted by Council on July 1, 2013 and approved by operation of law on July 10, 2013 the City and PATH entered into a Services Agreement (the "Agreement"); and
