A RESOLUTION BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITIES OF COLLEGE PARK, EAST POINT, FOREST PARK, HAPEVILLE, AND SANDY SPRINGS AND THE COUNTIES OF CLAYTON, COBB, DEKALB, AND FULTON TO PROVIDE MUTUAL AID ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE ATLANTA FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE AFOREMENTIONED CITIES AND COUNTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta and the Cities of College Park, East Point, Forest Park, Hapeville, and Sandy Springs and the Counties of Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, and Fulton (referred hereto as “Mutual Aid Pack”) have contiguous boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta and the “Mutual Aid Pack” each maintain and staff a fire department for the purpose of fire suppression, protection, prevention, rescue, emergency medical services, hazardous material, technical rescue and support services; and

WHEREAS, the “Mutual Aid Pack” and the City of Atlanta, Georgia have determined that it is mutually advantageous and beneficial to each of the parties to render the following services: supplemental fire prevention, fire suppression, emergency medical, hazardous material, technical rescue, and other local emergency services in addition to joint training exercises; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the signatories to enter into this agreement for mutual and first response, pursuant to the 1983 Constitution of the State of Georgia, Article IX, Section II, Paragraph 3; and

WHEREAS, Section 36-69-1, Et. seq. of the Official Code of Georgia authorizes extraterritorial cooperation and assistance to local fire departments and law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Atlanta have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Atlanta to provide for their mutual aid and protection in local emergencies by entering into a mutual aid agreement with the “Mutual Aid Pack;” and

WHEREAS, this Agreement shall be deemed to alter the terms of any existing Intergovernmental Agreements with the City of Sandy Springs and Fulton County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Atlanta, Georgia, those intergovernmental Agreements entitled, “AGREEMENT FOR MUTUAL AID”, for the mutual provision of fire protection between the fire department of the City of Atlanta and the “Mutual Aid Pack.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said agreement will not become binding on the City and the City will incur no liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney.
