Whereas, by memorandum dated June 25, 2014 (copy attached), Councilmember Joyce Sheperd of District 12, nominated Ms. Cameron to continue to serve as a member of the Audit Committee and now be appointed for a four-year term; and

Whereas, by memorandum dated July 2, 2014 (copy attached), Councilmember Mary Norwood, Chair of the Committee on Council, advised the City Council President and all Members of the City Council of Ms. Cameron's nomination for reappointment to the Audit Committee; and

Whereas, Ms. Cameron meets the qualifications to serve on the Audit Committee, in that she is a certified public accountant, is a resident of the City of Atlanta, possesses at least ten (10) years of experience and possesses other requirements necessary to carry out the duties required by City Charter Section 2-604. 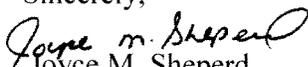

Dear President Mitchell and All Members of Council,

In a Memorandum dated May 19, 2014, I notified my colleagues, pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852, of the need for the Atlanta City Council to appoint or reappoint, as applicable, three (3) individuals to serve on the City of Atlanta Audit Committee in the at large seats for four-year terms each.

In response to my notification, on June 12, 2014, Councilmember Felicia Moore (District 9) submitted the nomination of Mr. Donald T. Penovi to be reappointed to serve on the City of Atlanta Audit Committee. Mr. Penovi, who is a C.P.A., is currently serving an expired term on the Audit Committee and is eligible to be reappointed to a second term that would be retroactive to begin on July 21, 2011 and end on July 20, 2015.

Further in response to my notification, on June 25, 2014, Councilmember Joyce Sheperd (District 12) submitted the nomination of Ms. Marion Cameron to serve on the City of Atlanta Audit Committee. Ms. Cameron, who is also a C.P.A., is eligible to be reappointed to a second term retroactive to begin on May 21, 2013 and expire on May 20, 2017.

Both resumes are attached.

Councilmember Carla Smith (District 1) also made a recommendation of an individual. However, all of the required paperwork has not yet been received and will be provided to you upon receipt.
