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

MOORE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AMENDMENT AGREEMENT NUMBER 3 WITH WRIGHT-BROWN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., FOR FC-5569, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR INSTALLATION OF SPEED RADAR SIGNS, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$18,000.00); WITH ALL CONTRACTED WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, DEPARTMENT, ORGANIZATION AND ACCOUNT LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) did solicit Bids for Contract Number FC-5569, Annual Professional Services for Installation of Traffic Signals, on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 12-R-0592 on May 21, 2012, and the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on May 30, 2012 which authorized the Agreement for FC-5569 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the base term of the Contract was for a period of one (1) year with two (2) one (1) year renewal options at the sole discretion of the City effective August 29, 2012 through August 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Office authorized a 90-day extension of the Contract on August 5, 2013 giving a new expiration date of November 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 13-R-3527 on September 3, 2013, and the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on September 12, 2013 which allowed the Department of Public Works to enter into Renewal Agreement Number 1 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc. effective November 26, 2013 through November 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Ordinance 13-O-1258 on September 16, 2013 and the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on September 25, 2013 which transferred \$64,000.00 from the District 5 Councilmembers Carry-Forward account into the Department of Public Works for the installation of digital speed limit signs; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 14-R-3000 on January 21, 2014 the same was approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on January 30, 2014 which allowed for Amendment Number 2 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc., for FC-5569, Professional Services for installation of traffic signals, on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to enter into Amendment Agreement Number 3 with Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc., for the installation of speed radar signs in District 9 in an amount not to exceed Eighteen Thousand and No Cents (\$18,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Wright-Brown Electric Company, Inc. has performed the contracted services satisfactorily; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Chief Procurement Officer recommended Amendment Agreement Number 3 for FC-5569, Professional Services for the installation speed radar signs.
