LEGISLATION HISTORY – BLUE BACK

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WHEREAS, Michael Smith having served the City of Atlanta (“City”) for 17 years retired in good standing from the Law Department effective September 4, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith has specialized knowledge critical to the Department of Aviation and his expertise with airline leases and all aspects of local government law including contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Atlanta authorizes that the City of Atlanta may reemploy a retiree for a period which may not exceed 520 business days, whether continuously or in separate days of employment for the purpose of availing the City of some particularized skill possessed by said retiree; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Aviation and Mr. Smith have mutually agreed to his reemployment as Deputy General Manager for a period not to exceed 520 business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA that the Atlanta City Council is authorized to reemploy Mr. Michael Smith as Deputy General Manager in the Department of Aviation as provided under Section 3-505 (c) of the Charter of the City of Atlanta.

A native Atlantan, Mr. Smith attended the Atlanta Public Schools. He graduated from Duke University in 1977 with a degree in Political Science and received his law degree in 1980 from North Carolina Central University. He became a member of the Georgia Bar Association that same year. Smith and his wife Pamela live in Atlanta. They have two adult children, Ashley and Christopher.

Michael L. Smith is currently in private practice specializing in local government law, airport and aviation matters with clients such as the City of Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

Prior to starting his own practice he most recently served as County Attorney for Clayton County, Georgia, a position he held from February 2005 to June 2011. In his capacity as lead attorney, he advised the Board of Commissioners, employees and other elected officials on all legal matters pertaining to the County.

Smith held positions with the City of Atlanta and Delta Air Lines, Inc., after beginning his legal career as Law Clerk for the Honorable Clarence Cooper, then Judge in the Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia.

Serving 17 years with the City of Atlanta as a Senior Assistant City Attorney, Smith gained considerable experience with all aspects of local government law, including litigation, contracts, property use and development, business and employment issues. He served as Atlanta's lead counsel representing the Department of Aviation, which oversees the operations of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. In this capacity, he was responsible for preparing and negotiating terms of agreements related to the airlines and other airport tenants, and helped prepare Intergovernmental Agreements with surrounding jurisdictions to implement airport projects, such as the Fifth Runway Project.

In September 2000 he accepted a position with Delta Air Lines, Inc. as a Regional Director in the Properties and Facilities Division (now Corporate Real Estate). As a Regional Director, Mr. Smith was responsible for representing Delta's interest at airports in his assigned region. His responsibilities included negotiating lease agreements, reviewing airport budgets which established the airlines rates and charges, providing input regarding various airport capital projects, identifying cost saving opportunities for Delta, and assisting in the implementation of various airline projects such as obtaining additional facilities for increasing service and placement of automated ticketing kiosk. Mr. Smith also served as Chairman of the Airline Airport Affairs Committee at various airports such as Orlando, Tampa, Jacksonville and Fort Myers, a role which required him to act as the primary liaison between the airlines and the airport's senior management.
