M. THERRELL HIGH SCHOOL AND MERGING WITH POLLING PLACES 11N & 11R DUE TO RENOVATIONS OF THE EXISTING FACILITY TO THE EXTENT THE POLLING PLACE WILL NO LONGER BE AVAILABLE FOR POLLING OPERATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
(HELD 9/8/15) (HELD AT THE REQUEST OF THE MUNICIPAL CLERK) (SUBSTITUTED AND HELD 11/16/15)**

WHEREAS, the 2013 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance was adopted by the Atlanta City Council on August 19, 2013; and

WHEREAS, such Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on November 04 2013, May 05 2014, July 21 2014, October 06 2014, March 02 2015, June 01 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections, the designated Election Superintendent for the conduct of City of Atlanta Elections, has approved changes to City of Atlanta Precinct/Polling Place 11M; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections has notified the City of certain changes to City of Atlanta Precinct/Polling Place 11M; and

WHEREAS, affected voters will be notified of these changes by the Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council, believes that ratification of these changes should be made by this Body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections of changes to Precinct/Polling Place 11M by permanently moving Precinct 11M to D. M. Therrell High School, where Precincts 11N and 11R is currently located;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 2013 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, adopted by the Council on August 19, 2013 (codified as Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances; and adopted by reference) by adding the recent change to Precinct/Polling Place 11M.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that certain particular changes described above and detailed below and identified by the attachment shown as Exhibit A which is reflected or incorporated in the August 17, 2015 Revision to the 2013 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, and reflected in Attachment I

to this ordinance, with all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:

SECTION 1. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 11M located at Kimberly Elementary School, 3090 McMurray Drive, SW by permanently moving said precinct to D. M. Therrell High School, 3099 Panther Trail, SW, due to renovations of the existing polling facility in which the polling place will no longer be available for polling operations; attached hereto and identified as Exhibit A. The proposed facility is handicap accessible and approximately 0.7 miles from the existing facility. All affected voters will be notified of this change by first-class mail.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE BY COMMITTEE ON COUNCIL

TO AMEND CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 66-2 "PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES AND POLLING PLACES" BY AMENDING THE 2013 PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES ORDINANCE IN PRECINCT 11M BY PERMANENTLY MOVING SAID PRECINCT TO D. M. THERRELL HIGH SCHOOL AND MERGING WITH POLLING PLACES 11N & 11R DUE TO RENOVATIONS OF THE EXISTING FACILITY TO THE EXTENT THE POLLING PLACE WILL NO LONGER BE AVAILABLE FOR POLLING OPERATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 2013 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance was adopted by the Atlanta City Council on August 19, 2013; and

WHEREAS, such Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on November 04 2013, May 05 2014, July 21 2014, October 06 2014, March 02 2015, June 01 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections, the designated Election Superintendent for the conduct of City of Atlanta Elections, has approved changes to City of Atlanta Precinct/Polling Place 11M; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections has notified the City of certain changes to City of Atlanta Precinct/Polling Place 11M; and

WHEREAS, affected voters will be notified of these changes by the Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council, believes that ratification of these changes should be made by this Body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections of changes to Precinct/Polling Place 11M by permanently moving Precinct 11M to D. M. Therrell High School, where Precincts 11N and 11R is currently located;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 2013 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, adopted by the Council on August 19, 2013 (codified as Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances; and adopted by reference) by adding the recent change to Precinct/Polling Place 11M.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that certain particular changes described above and detailed below and identified by the attachment shown as Exhibit A which is reflected or incorporated in the August 17, 2015 Revision to the 2013 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, and reflected in Attachment I to this ordinance, with all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:

SECTION 1. To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 11M located at Kimberly Elementary School, 3090 McMurray Drive, SW by permanently moving said precinct to D. M. Therrell High School, 3099 Panther Trail, SW**, due to renovations of the existing polling facility in which the polling place will no longer be available for polling operations; attached hereto and identified as Exhibit A. The proposed facility is handicap accessible and approximately 0.7 miles from the existing facility. All affected voters will be notified of this change by first-class mail.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




