Should be ready to move by December 2, 2015.**
2. Chairperson Moore asked Miguel Southwell, Aviation GM, to be prepared to give a presentation or update on permitting and regulating Transportation Company's like Uber and Lyft at HJAI, at one of the upcoming Transportation Committee meetings. The presentation should provide a summary of the procedures that will be put in place and should let the committee know if the council will need to introduce legislation. **A work session was held on July 24, 2015. A second work session will be scheduled.**






