PreTrial Diversion and Deferred Prosecution Program

FY18 Q3 Update

This program provides offenders an alternative to prosecution and possible conviction on traffic and non-traffic cases. This is accomplished by early screening prior to booking which allows defendants to resolve their cases prior to court.

Community Prosecution Outreach Initiatives

FY18 Q3 Update

In addition to our role in traditional prosecution and court proceedings, the Solicitor's Office incorporates community prosecution's problem-solving techniques to develop solutions to address the unique concerns in the community.

One of our community outreach initiatives includes the **Fight Against Blight (F.A.B.) Educational Symposium:**

- Sponsored by Councilmember Andrea Boone, District 10 and Mayor's Office of Constituent Services
- 100+ citizens attended
- 8 City departments presented
- 870 scrap tires collected
- 160 smoke detectors distributed and signed up individuals for fire home safety assessments





Community Prosecution Outreach Initiatives (cont'd)– FY18 Q3 Update

Student Outreach and Resource Program (S.O.A.R.)

- 1st Public Safety Field Day - Margaret Fain Elementary
- Court Tour for at-risk students with Police Foundation At-Promise Center
- Team Building Session with staff and students at the At-Promise Center
- 5th Safe Driving and Driver Responsibility College Tour at Georgia State University to promote safe driving responsibilities to young drivers. More than 350 students were engaged.

Attended **NPU and Community Meetings** to educate citizens about code enforcement violations, the responsibilities of home ownership, property maintenance, and court proceedings. More than 81 person hours were dedicated in FY18 Q3.

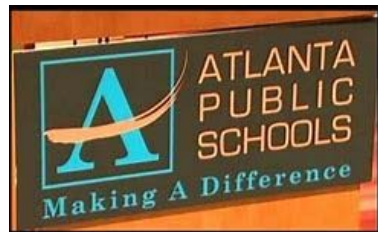
