

## MORE MARTA ATLANTA PROGRAM

- Unanimous Approval by MARTA Board of Directors
- \$2.7 billion in sales tax over 40 years
- Additional public/private funding to be sought
- Targeted Investments:
  - ✓ 22 Miles Light Rail Transit (LRT)
  - √ 14 Miles Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)
  - √ 26 Miles Arterial Rapid Transit (ART)
  - 2 New Transit Centers
  - ✓ Additional Fixed-Route Bus Service
  - ✓ Upgrades to existing Rail Stations
- Two Years of Comprehensive Planning and Outreach
- Nine Guiding Principles
- Opportunities for more transit





## THE PEOPLE'S PRIORITIES

Based on public feedback, MARTA and City leaders refined the program, with emphasis on:

#### **Atlanta BeltLine**

\$570M

Plan builds out **61%** of City-adopted Atlanta BeltLine Streetcar Plan

#### Southeast/Southwest

\$600M+

Includes LRT on Campbellton & SW BeltLine and BRT link to downtown

#### **Station Enhancements**

\$200M

Includes better access, amenities and ADA enhancements

#### **Clifton Corridor**

\$250M

Plus additional **\$100M** contingent on securing other local funding

#### Downtown/Streetcar

\$553M

Connects BeltLine with downtown destinations and existing Streetcar

### **Bus System**

\$238M

Includes more frequent bus service and new circulator routes



BeltLine Loop- LRT (not included in subtotal costs and LRT mileage)




Beltline Loop- LRT (not included in subtotal costs and LRT mileage)



# MORE MARTA IMPLEMENTATION TO DATE

- MARTA has already responded to public feedback. Since 2017, the agency added:
  - √ 3 local bus routes
  - √ 1 express bus route
  - √ 10 community circulators
  - ✓ Atlanta Streetcar transition to MARTA
  - ✓ 3 routes with frequency and span aligned with rail
  - √ 32 routes with increased service frequencies
  - √ 32 routes with increased spans of service





## **OUTCOMES OF THE INVESTMENT**

- Increases mobility for workers to and from major job centers
- Connects Atlanta's colleges and universities
- Offers balanced investment within the city
- Layers and integrates with existing transit network
- Provides last-mile connectivity
- Maximizes investment through innovative funding approaches
- Aligns with city vision for:
  - ✓ Growth
  - Conservation
  - Density
  - Mobility





## MORE MARTA ATLANTA NEXT STEPS


- Programming of projects

- Regular reporting to MARTA Board and Atlanta City Council




## TRANSIT AMENITIES – EXISTING CONDITIONS

231 Current shelters






## TRANSIT AMENITIES - FUTURE EXPANSION

 An additional 431 stops qualify for amenities in the future


305 Qualified for benches

## **BUS STOP AMENITIES**

- 20% of Senior Activity Centers in Atlanta have Shelters.
- 30% of Senior Centers have a Shelter or Simme Seat.
- 35% of Atlanta Public Schools (middle and high schools) have Shelters.
- 82% of the Shopping Centers identified have a shelter or bench within walking distance.
