Prostitution Complaints

- COPS conducts outreach in Midtown to offer social services
- Pre-Arrest Diversion will be implemented in parts of Zone 5 and Zone 6
- Midtown officers patrol the area to deter the “johns” from cruising
- Coordinate with Corrections to board up vacant properties
- Crime Suppression Units making arrests, Utilize VIC cameras where available

Video Integration Center

- Near 8,000 cameras into the VIC
- 250+ new cameras added YTD
- 150 additional LPRs in process (Renew Atlanta)
