

The promoter responsible for any given concert in Chastain Park or Lakewood Amphitheaters shall be responsible for complying with this sound ordinance and for any fines arising out of violations thereof.

A violation of this ordinance shall occur as to any concert if two (2) readings from the Monitor exceed the 85 decibel sound level.

If a sound meter or the Monitor does not work for a period of time during a concert or for a concert so that no or insufficient readings can be obtained, such will constitute a violation for the purposes of this ordinance.

Readings of the decibel levels of concerts at Chastain Park and Lakewood Amphitheaters shall be available with the City of Atlanta within two (2) weeks following any given concert, so the promoter in question, the appropriate neighborhood (Chastain Park or Lakewood Neighborhood), and the City of Atlanta are aware of the current status of compliance with this ordinance.

There shall be fines for violations of this sound ordinance at Chastain Park and Lakewood Amphitheaters as follows:

1 st time (in a calendar year)	-	no fine
2 nd time	-	\$2,000
3 rd time	-	\$3,000
4 th time	-	\$4,000
5 th time	-	\$5,000

The fines shall be payable within thirty (30) days of the date of the violation. Any fines collected for violations at Chastain Park Amphitheater shall only go towards improvements in Chastain Park Amphitheater and/or immediate surrounding area. Similarly, any fines collected for violations at Lakewood Amphitheater shall only go towards improvements in Lakewood Amphitheater and/or immediate surrounding area. Those improvements shall be determined by a joint 6 member panel consisting of: two (2) from the City of Atlanta's Department of Parks and Recreation; two (2) from the Joint Venture of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra and Southern Promotions; and two (2) from the respective neighborhood (i.e. Chastain Park neighborhood for Chastain Park Amphitheater fines collected and Lakewood neighborhood for Lakewood Amphitheater fines collected).

SECTION 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
