ATLANTA – Atlanta City Councilmember Michael Julian Bond will honor The S.O.S. Band (Sounds of Success) during today's meeting of the Atlanta City Council.

The public is invited to come meet The S.O.S Band at a 12:30 p.m. reception at Atlanta City Hall. KISS 104.1 radio personalities will join Councilman Bond for the 1:00 p.m. proclamation presentation.

The R&B group formed in Atlanta in 1977 and is best known for the songs "Take Your Time," "Just Be Good to Me," and "Tell Me If You Still Care."

The group's first single, "Take Your Time," was released in 1980 and sold over two million copies. The debut album went gold – selling over 800,000 copies.

The S.O.S. Band is being recognized for influencing a generation of music with its rich vocals, creative arrangements, and innovative songs.
