On **Saturday, July 9, 2016** at the Adamsville Recreation Center’s ball field (3201 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, S.W.) the thriller seeking movie of *The Karate Kid 2* will be shown.

*The Karate Kid 2* is a 2010 Chinese-American martial arts comedy-drama film directed by Harald Zwart and starring Jackie Chan and Jaden Smith. Unlike the original movie, this remake is set in China, and features Kung Fu instead of Karate. The plot concerns 12-year-old Dre (Smith) from Detroit, Michigan who moves to Beijing, China with his mother (Henson) and runs afoul of the neighborhood bully (Wang). He makes an unlikely ally in the form of an

aging maintenance man, Mr. Han (Chan), a Kung Fu master who teaches him the secrets of self-defense.

On **Saturday, July 23, 2016** at West Manor Park (3240 W. Manor Circle, S.W.) Walt Disney's animated animal comedy "Zootopia" will be shown.

*Zootopia* is a 2016 American 3D computer-animated buddy cop comedy adventure film produced by Walt Disney Animation Studios and released by Walt Disney Pictures. It is the 55th animated feature in the Walt Disney Animated Classics series. The film details the unlikely partnership between a rabbit police officer and a red fox con artist as they uncover a conspiracy that involves the disappearance of predator civilians within a mammalian metropolis.

Attendees are encouraged to bring blankets, chairs, and picnic baskets. All park rules will apply.
