Councilmember Michael Julian Bond will honor these Women of Radio with a proclamation at 1pm on Monday, June 20th at Atlanta City Hall. There will be a reception before the presentation at noon on the 2nd floor Southwest Atrium adjacent to Atlanta City Council Chamber.

Carol Blackmon started in Atlanta as a radio announcer at 1380 WIGO, and then joined V-103. Shortly after, she hosted Midday Café on Majic 107.5/97.5 for 7 years and the Georgia Lottery for 20 years.

Myrna Ransom is the first Female Personality of V-103. She has over 17th years of broadcasting experience. She was named Media Woman of the Year in 1986, received the Spot News Award from Associate Press in 1988 and covered the 1996 Summer Olympics for ABC News.

Sylvia McAfee landed her first job on KISS 104.1, and then moved on to 107.5 FM as one of the “Weekend Warrior” crew members. She also worked on other radio stations as well throughout the country.

Michele Williams began to pursue her love in radio at the age of 16 and currently has over 37 years of experience as a radio/television personality host. She was the first female radio personality on KISS 104.1. Today, she is the president and owner of Atlanta Casting and Talent
