City of Atlanta opens Warming Center Due to Frigid Weather

WHO: The City of Atlanta, Mayor's Office of Constituent Services and the Department of Parks and Recreation

WHAT: Warming Center remains open for citizens who need shelter from the cold

WHEN: Monday, January 11, 2016
6:00 pm -10:00 am

WHERE: Old Adamsville emergency shelter 3404 Delmar Lane Atlanta

The City of Atlanta will continue to operate a warming center to offer shelter from the freezing weather that has enveloped the city over the past 48 hours. The center located at the Old Adamsville Recreation Center 3404 Delmar Lane, will provide shelter and light refreshments for those seeking refuge from the below normal temperatures.

The Mayor's Office of Constituent Services has staff members traveling throughout the city seeking and informing those who may need shelter from the inclement weather.

“We are committed to reaching out to those who are in need of a warm place from the seriously cold weather”, said Councilmember C.T. Martin, District 10. “As temperatures begin to plummet our homeless population and those without power face life-threatening situations if they have no shelter from the cold. We have a responsibility to care for our most vulnerable citizens” Martin said.
