

- District 11 keeps its neighborhoods north of Cascade Road
- District 5 expands northward to cover Druid Hills
- District 10 expands into the Dixie Hills and Douglass High School parts of District 3
- District 6 grows up the east side of Peachtree Street to the BeltLine
  - Precinct 07E is split at Buford Hwy
  - Precinct 06G is spilt along Monroe Dr.
  - Precinct 03T is spilt along MLK Jr. Dr.
