REDISTRICTING PROCESS**

The following information provides an overview of the “Plan 6 – Redistricting Map as Amended 01/17/2012”.

District One (2010 population: 32,660) ..

Adds Capitol Gateway and a portion of downtown - mainly GA State

District Two (2010 population: 48,110) ..

Retains western portion of Grady High School Campus

Adds Candler Park and maintains the MLK historic site extending to I-75 along Auburn Ave and Irwin St

Relinquished Atlantic Station, Home Park, GA Tech, and a portion of downtown

District Three (2010 population: 31,530) ..

Maintains Dixie Hills and Douglas High School .. Adds Home Park, Atlantic Station, GA Tech

Relinquished the AUC ... portions of Grove Park & Mozley Park

District Four (2010 population: 28,166) ..

Adds the Atlanta University Center, portions of Mozley Park and downtown extending to North Ave

Relinquished Adair Park and Pittsburgh

District Five (2010 population: 29,882) ..

Adds portion of downtown from P'tree Center Ave to Boulevard excluding the MLK historic site

District Six (2010 population: 39,455) ..

Keeps the Virginia Highlands community in-tack .. maintains Druid Hills & Ansley Park .. retains eastern portion of Grady High School Campus

Adds Brookwood Hills & Lindbergh

Relinquishes Candler Park and a portion of Midtown

District Seven (2010 population: 43,772) ..

Keeps the Pine Hills neighborhood

Relinquishes Brookwood Hills and Lindbergh

District Eight (2010 population: 38,063) ..

Keeps Loring Heights

Relinquishes Berkeley Park

District Nine (2010 population: 30,619) ..

Adds Berkeley Park and portion of Grove Park

District Ten (2010 population: 30,707) ..

Adds Audobon Forest West and portions of Green Forest Acres, Cascade Heights, Audobon Forest, Beecher Hills and Westwood Terrace

District Eleven (2010 population: 39,914) ..

Maintains the Cascade Avenue neighborhood

Relinquished Audobon Forest West and portions of Green Forest Acres, Cascade Heights, Audobon Forest, Beecher Hills and Westwood Terrace

Splits the Delowe Drive neighborhood w/ District 12 at Fort Valley & Pinehurst Drive maintaining the western portion

District Twelve (2010 population: 27,125) ..

Adds Adair Park and Pittsburgh communities

Adds Eastern portion of Delowe Drive Neighborhood at Fort Valley & Pinehurst Drive
