






GDOT

State Routes in City of Atlanta

- 3, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 42, 54, 139, 141, 154, 166, 236, 237, 260, 280, 400
- Nine additional spurs, connectors, and one way pairs (see map)
- We use numbers because each number has multiple street names at every city or county boundary, some even within your own jurisdiction
- Approximately 108.5 centerline miles
- Approximately 19% of D7 lane miles

State Route Resurfacing

Coming Soon

- Ponce de Leon Avenue
 - from Moreland/Briarcliff to the City Limits
 - Piedmont to Moreland/Briarcliff was done as part of safety project in 2014/2015
- Freedom Parkway from Boulevard to Ponce
- Moreland Avenue from DeKalb Ave to Freedom Parkway
 - Safety project let in September
 - Remainder of Moreland (DeKalb county to Ponce excluding safety project) scheduled for FY 2022
- Briarcliff Road from Ponce to northern city limit (Spring/Summer 2020)
- H.E. Holmes Drive from Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive to D.L. Hollowell
- James Jackson Parkway from D.L. Hollowell to Cobb County line

Maintenance Priorities

What is important to our customers?

- Aesthetics
- Pavement condition
- Visible stripes
- Congestion



Maintenance on State Routes in Local Municipalities: GA Code 32-2-2

...on those portions of the state highway system lying within the corporate limits of any municipality...

The department shall be required to provide **only substantial maintenance activities and operations**, including but not limited to reconstruction and major resurfacing, reconstruction of bridges, erection and maintenance of official department signs, painting of striping and pavement delineators, furnishing of guardrails and bridge rails, and other major maintenance activities

Maintenance on State Routes in Local Municipalities: GA Code 32-2-2

GDOT Responsibilities include:

- **Substantial Maintenance**
- Resurfacing
- Signing/Pavement Marking
- Providing materials for Guardrail Repair

City Responsibilities include:

- **Routine Maintenance**
- Sidewalk Repair
- Minor Pavement Repair including Potholes

Districtwide Maintenance Activities

1. Litter & Mowing
 - 30 day cycles on interstates
 - 45 day cycles on state routes
 - More frequently than other districts
 - \$8.3 million/year
 - 25% of total annual budget for D7; previously 1/3
 - Some local governments do intermediate cycles
 - Schedule published on external website

Other Districtwide Maintenance Activities (other 75%)

2. Sweeping of Interstate Shoulders
3. Guardrail Repair (all routes, exceeding what is required by state law)
4. Pavement Preservation
5. Concrete pavement rehabilitation
6. Interstate Fence Repair
7. Vegetation Management (more since HB 170)
8. Sound wall cleaning and repair (new since HB 170)
9. Emergency Response
 - Snow and Ice
 - Special Events
 - Flooding
 - Downed Trees
 - Urban Camping Clean up



Lighting

Always requires local agreement

- Requests for new lights can be made during major construction project
- Requests for stand-alone lighting projects
 - Atlanta Regional Commission
 - Livable Communities Initiative (LCI)
 - Transportation Enhancement/Transportation Alternatives Programs
 - Will always require a local maintenance agreement for power & maintenance

Traffic Signals

- Similar to highway lighting, traffic signals have to have power
- Local agreement required for any new signals
- 975 Traffic signals in City of Atlanta
- 320 are 100% local
- Approximately 530 in RTOP
 - locally maintained; local power
 - GDOT-operated (timing plans/active monitoring)
 - Equipment upgrades funded by GDOT
- Approximately 120 other state route locations
 - Local power
 - GDOT maintenance and operation



Urban Camping

- GDOT can move stuff, but not people
- Enforcement Enabled by Legislation
 - SB 445
 - Georgia Code 32-6-6
 - City Ordinance 106-12
- Violation should not require “complainant” like trespassing
- GDOT cooperates with
 - Department of Corrections
 - APD, including HOPE Team
 - Need to know who will be taking the lead if/when Corrections is dissolved
