


AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES TO CONDUCT A PAY AND CLASSIFICATION STUDY OF THE SALARY AND PAYMENT STRUCTURE OF NON-SWORN EMPLOYEES OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CODE ENFORCEMENT SECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Housing Code of 1987, (Atlanta Housing Code), has as its purpose to provide for the maintenance of the minimum requirements necessary for the protection of life, limb, health, property, safety and welfare of the general public and the owners and occupants of residential property in the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Police Department's Code Enforcement Section has responsibility for the enforcement and administration of the Atlanta Housing Code of 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Police Department's Code Enforcement Section is made up of sworn and non-sworn employees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta is committed to ensuring that salary and compensation levels of employees in the Atlanta Police Department's Code Enforcement Section are appropriate in keeping with their qualifications and levels of responsibility; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Atlanta to review and evaluate the salary and payment structure of the non-sworn employees assigned to the Atlanta Police Department's Code Enforcement Section.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Atlanta City Council, that the Commissioner of the Department of Human Resources shall be authorized to conduct a study of the salary and payment structure of the non-sworn employees assigned to the Atlanta Police Department's Code Enforcement Section.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Human Resources shall report back any findings to the Public Safety and Legal Administration and Finance/Executive Committees of the Atlanta City Council and recommend a plan of action by no later than December 31, 2019.
