CODE ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE: COVID-19

Inspections

- Complaints filed through ATL311 and online at coderequests@atlantaga.gov
 - 2204 complaints filed (down 52% from 2019)
- Sworn personnel conducted field inspections
- Property ownership determined
 - Staff contacting property owners to gain voluntary inspections (exterior and interior complaints)
 - 639 cases complied

COMPLIANCE RESOLUTION FY20 ACTIVITY

Demolition Activity

- Executed Demolitions 100
 - 59 more than FY19
 - 33% less than FY20 goal


▪ Awarded Demolitions 57

Clean and Close Activity

▪ Executed Clean and Closes 41

▪ Awarded Clean and Closes 20





CODE ENFORCEMENT SECTION

RETURN TO WORK PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

- Code Enforcement staff return to work August 3, 2020
 - Inspectors conducting inspections (exterior inspections only)
 - Administrative support staff processing Notices of Non-Compliance letters
 - Encourage voluntary compliance and vacant property registration
 - Court and In Rem preparation
 - Municipal court remains closed to the public
 - In Rem proceedings suspended
