

- ENGINE 1 – DS WINDSHIELD CRACKED
- ENGINE 3 – DENT/GOUGE TO UPPER TO CAB AND PUMP PANEL
- ENGINE 6 – CAB DOOR DENT/GOUGE & REAR CAB DOOR DENT/GOUGE
- ENGINE 21 – DENT/GOUGE ABOVE HEADLIGHT & DENT/GOUGE TO MIDDLE BODY ROLL-UP DOOR
- TRUCK 21 – DOOR WINDOW SHATTERED, DENT TO DRIVER DOOR, DENT/GOUGE IN BETWEEN DRIVER & REAR DS CAB DOOR, DENT TO REAR DOOR & DENT TO CAB DOOR
- ENGINE 29 (RESERVE) – ENTIRE WINDSHIELD SHATTERED, GRILL DENTED, FRONT CAB DENT/GOUGE, UPPER & LOWER COMPARTMENTS DENTED, HARD SUCTION HOLDER DENTED, CAB ROOF EDGE BETWEEN FRONT AND REAR DOOR DENTED/GOUGED & TOP OF CAB DENTED/GOUGED BETWEEN FRONT AND REAR DOOR

- SQUAD 4 (RESERVE) – DENT TO REAR BODY COMPARTMENT DOOR.
