
















#### JUNKED VEHICLES PROCESS – FY22

- Removal of junked vehicles from private property only
- ❖58 junked vehicles towed
- ❖ 561 placarded junked vehicles complied (registered or removed)
- 44 placarded junked vehicles pending tow
- ❖ Dial 911 for junked vehicles parked on the street



### ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT CODE ENFORCEMENT SECTION

#### COMPLIANCE RESOLUTION – FY22

- 79 demolitions executed
- 44 clean and closes executed
- 76 clean and cuts executed
- ❖ 37 demolitions awarded to city contractors
- 92 demolition orders issued
- 2 clean and closes awarded to city contractor
- ❖ 20 clean and cuts awarded to city contractor
- ❖ 1,386 complaints filed pending city abatement
  - 990 pending Administrative In Rem review
  - ❖ 396 pending clean and cut







#### PROCESS IMPROVEMENTS

- Legislation pending to revise the 1987 Atlanta Housing Code
- **❖** Dedicated staff to train new and existing Code Enforcement Officers
- Collaborations with other city departments and outside agencies
  - Fulton County Environmental Health Division
- Remotely operated Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) also known as Drones
