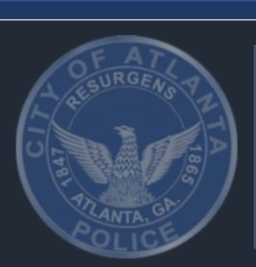

- Search warrant obtained, due to the violent history of the suspect, SWAT is notified.
- Fugitive, SWAT, TFO's, Negotiators, Zone 4 personnel all respond and collaborate.
- Suspect taken into custody without incident.
- Suspect wanted from a shooting incident in October of 2020 in Zone 6. Convicted Felon with 11 arrest cycles.

Demetrius McDowell Jr. is wanted in relation to an October 24th, 2020 aggravated assault.

On that day at approximately 12:28PM, Atlanta Police responded to 243 Florida Ave SW in reference to a person shot. Upon arrival officers located an 18-year-old male with apparent gunshot wounds to both arms. He was later transported to the hospital in stable condition. Officers were able to speak with witnesses at the location who advised that two males in separate vehicles stopped in front of the house and after speaking with someone there, the males fired towards the home from their vehicles, striking the victim. The suspects then fled the scene. The GAT Unit was requested to the scene to take lead on the investigation. Investigators with GAT were eventually able to identify one of the suspects as Demetrius McDowell Jr. and warrants were issued for his arrest.

Fugitive investigators are now requesting the public's assistance in locating Mr. McDowell Jr. Anyone with information on his whereabouts is asked to contact Crime Stoppers. Information can be submitted anonymously to the Crime Stoppers Atlanta tip line at 404-577-TIPS (8477) or online at www.StopCrimeATL.com. Persons do not have to give their name or any identifying information to be eligible for the reward of up to \$2,000 for the arrest and indictment of the suspect.





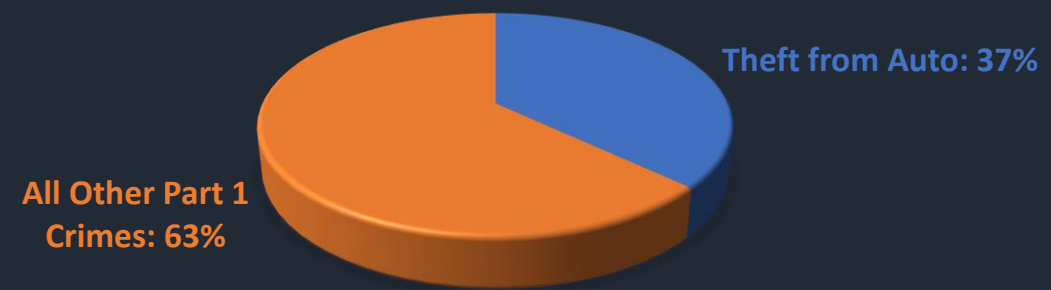

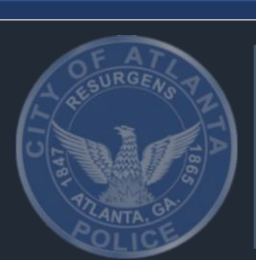

- One individual was arrested 89 times

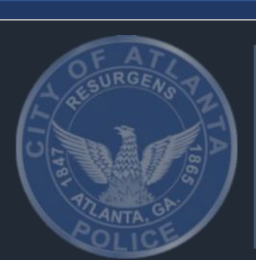
