Who are we?

An independent investigative agency authorized to investigate the actions of Atlanta police and corrections officers.

How do we do our work?

Fairly, Thoroughly, and Independently with Integrity

What do we stand for?

We support citizen confidence in policing by having the best officers serving the community.

Why?

To enhance public safety through the promotion of officer accountability

Jurisdictional Requirements

Complaint:

- Must involve Atlanta Police or Corrections officers
- Must be filed within 365 days from the date of the encounter
- Must sign complaint
- May file anonymously
- Can file by phone, website, email, in-person
- Can self-initiate investigations involving discharge of a firearm, stun gun, or taser in a manner that results in death or serious bodily injury, where a person has died or sustained serious bodily injury while in police custody, and all incidents of an "officerinvolved death."



Accepted Allegations

- abuse of authority
- abusive language
- appropriate action required
- conduct
- discrimination
- discriminatory reference
- failing to provide identification

- false arrest
- false imprisonment
- harassment
- retaliation
- use of excessive force
- serious bodily injury
- death

Catch-all – violation of department standard operating procedures which is alleged to be the result of the actions of a sworn employee of the police department or department of corrections


Complaints Received – 32

- ➤ Assigned for Full Investigation 12
- ➤ Complaints Dismissed 16
- ➤ Complaints awaiting Signed Complaint 4
- APD Zones 4 and 7 received the most complaints
- Council Districts 2, 4 and 5 received the majority of complaints

Closed Investigations – 8

Open Complaint Investigations – 28


