#### **GEMA Measures Indexes**

- O The overall Protective Measures Index for the Atlanta City Detention Center is 74.4, which is higher than the average of 41.6 and the comparison high of 62.8 when compared to 117 similar facilities of the comparison group.
- O The overall Resilience Measures Index for the Atlanta City Detention Center is 57.4, which is above the average of 41.6 when compared to 117 other assessed similar facilities of the comparison group.






