- Federal Transportation Funds withheld from Atlanta region
- In response, ARC Board creates LCI program

Refining the Program (2011-Today)

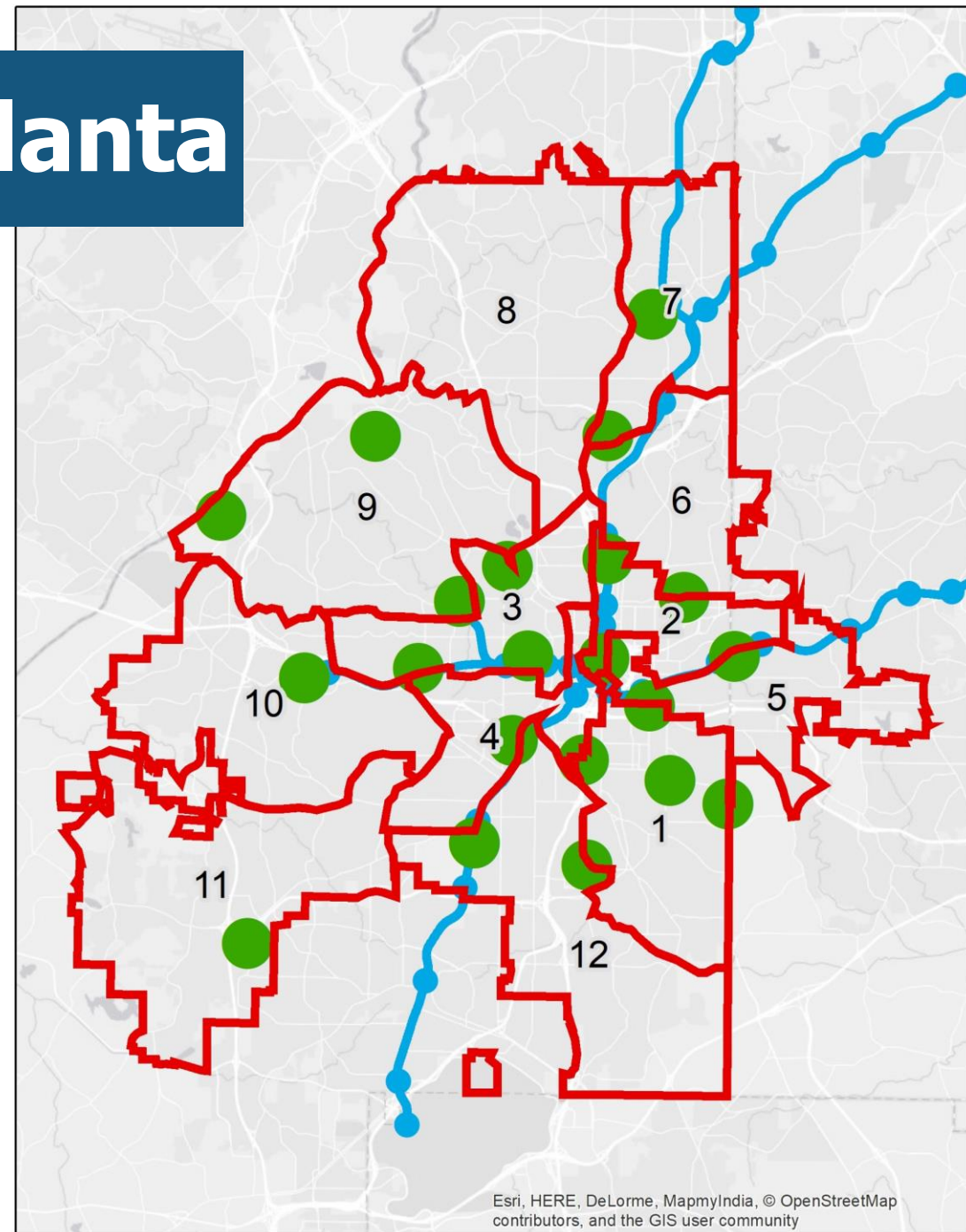
- ARC offers transportation project management services

- \$2.68 Million in Study Funds
 - 43 Studies throughout the City
- Over \$59 Million in Transportation Funding
 - 26 Transportation Projects
