## Electronic Health Records (EHR) System

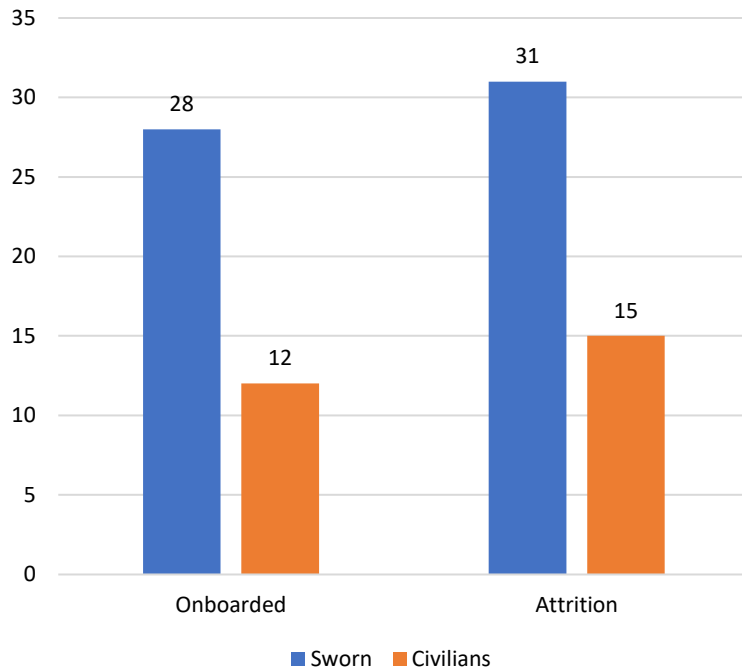
- To provide more efficient medical care and education to individual housed in the DOC.

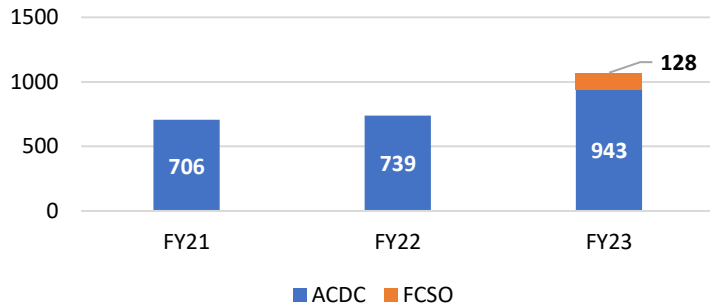

### ACDC Statistics: Total Bookings & Average Daily Population (ADP)

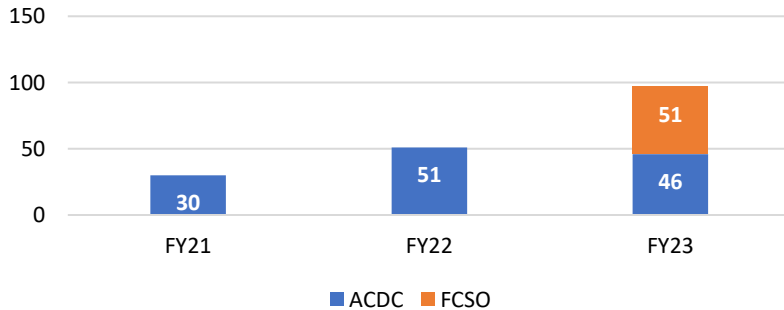

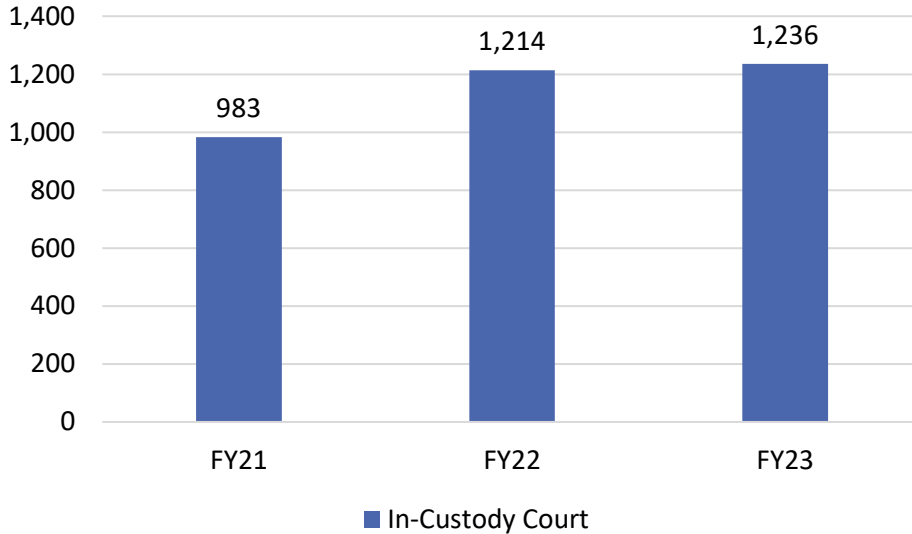

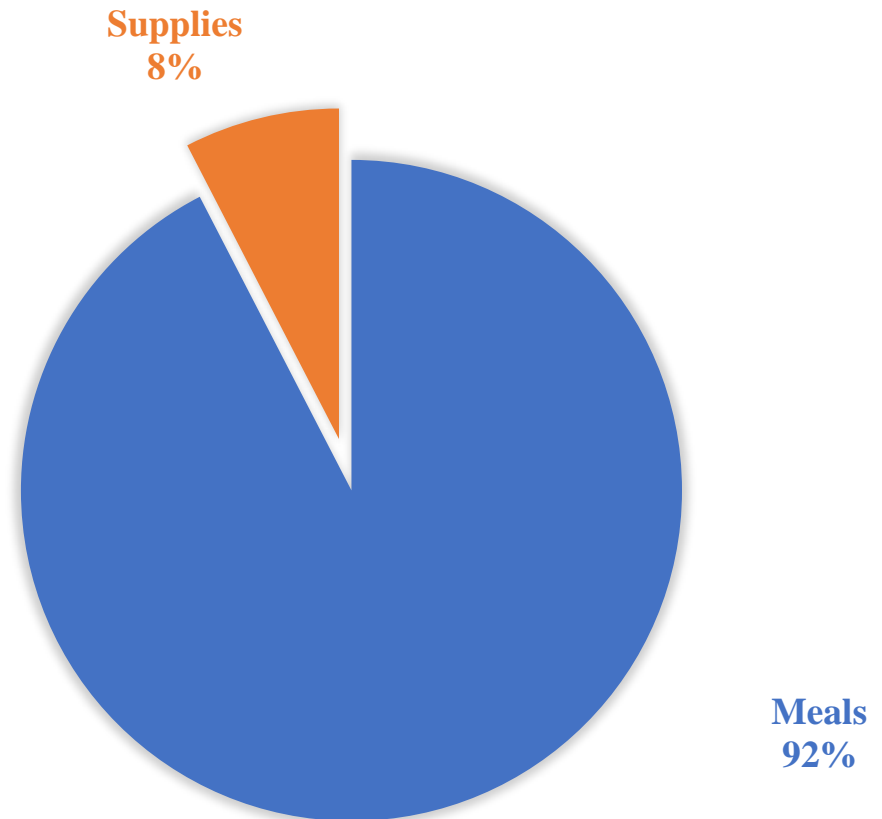

## *Beyond the Walls of ACDC*



### ***Warming Centers Activations***

- Department of Corrections (DOC) joined with several municipalities to provide a safe, clean, and warm space for the community and homeless population during extreme weather conditions in the surrounding areas in the City of Atlanta.
- DOC prepared and transported a total of 7,573 meals.
- 2,149 blankets were washed for the Warming Centers during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
- Nine (9) total activations for three (3) Warming Centers.

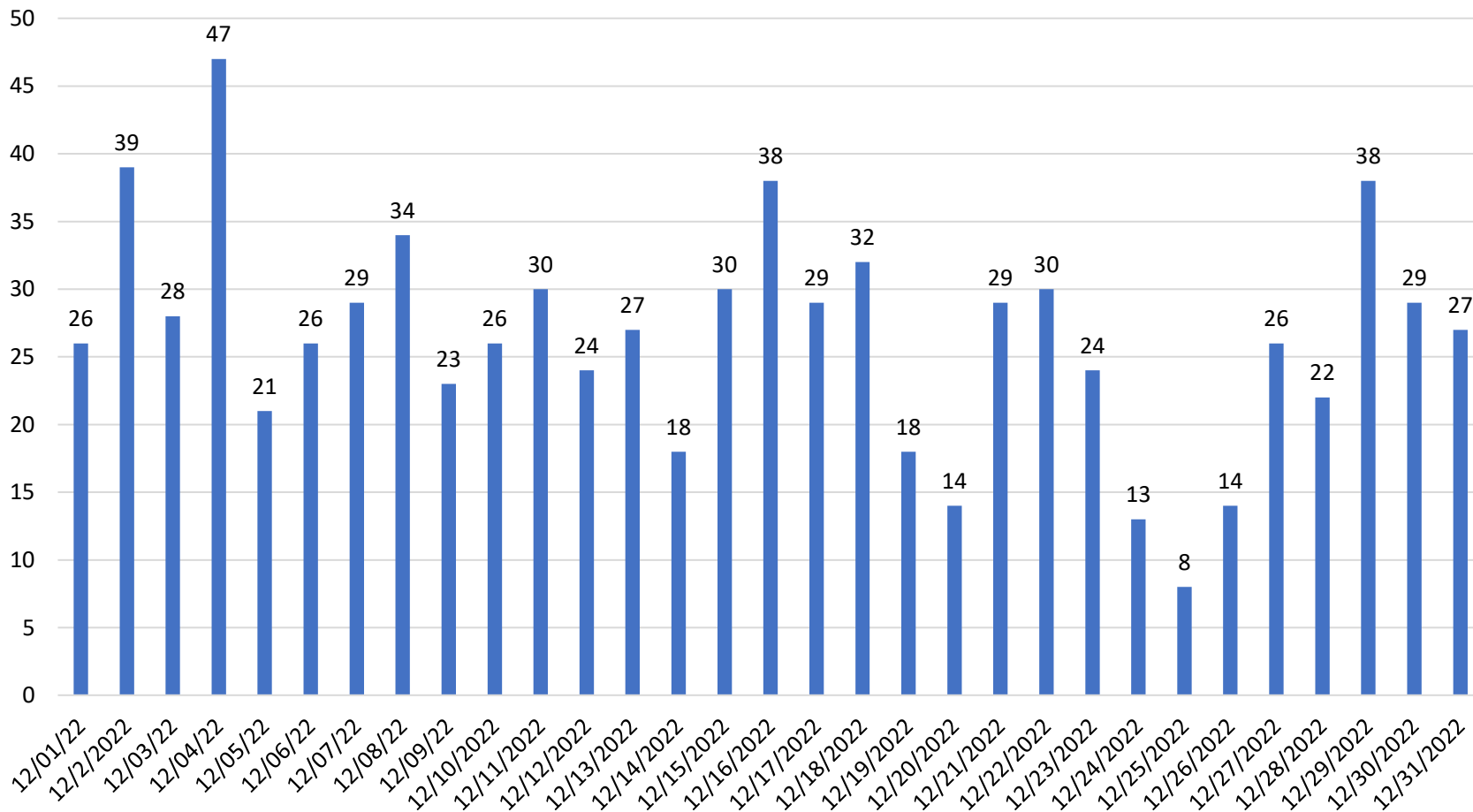

# ACDC Total Bookings: 819 December 2022



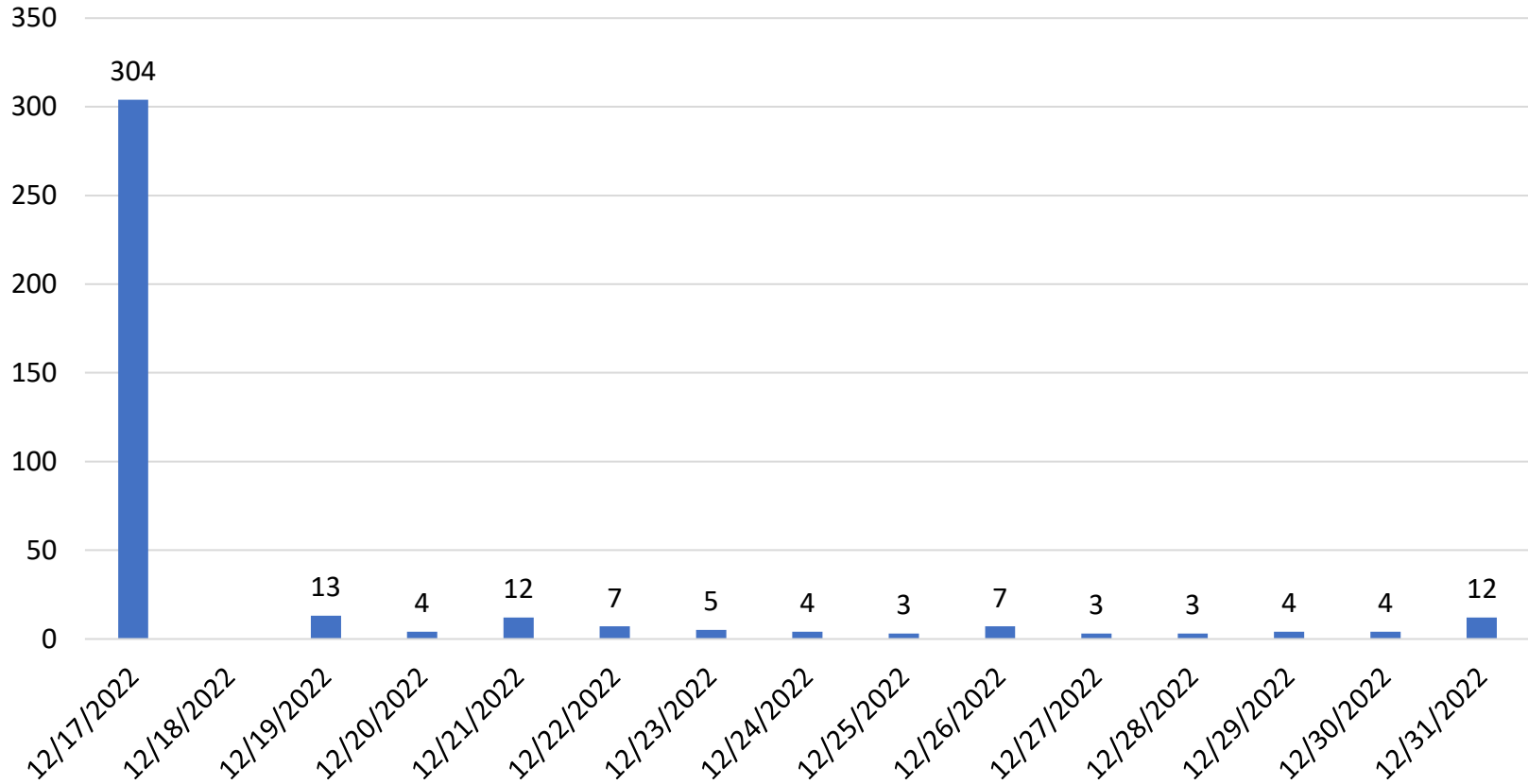

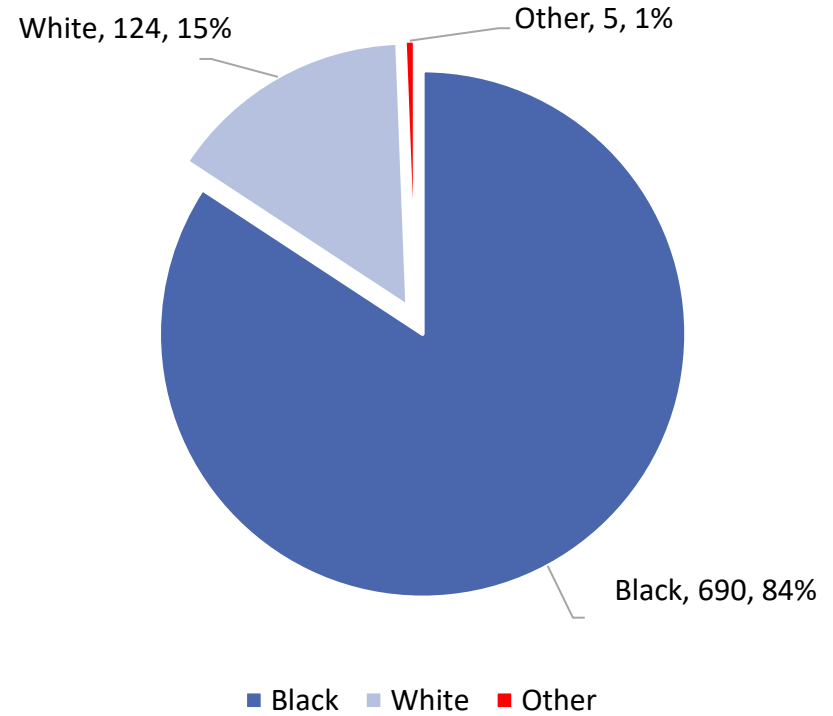

# Demographics By Race ACDC Detainees Only December 2022

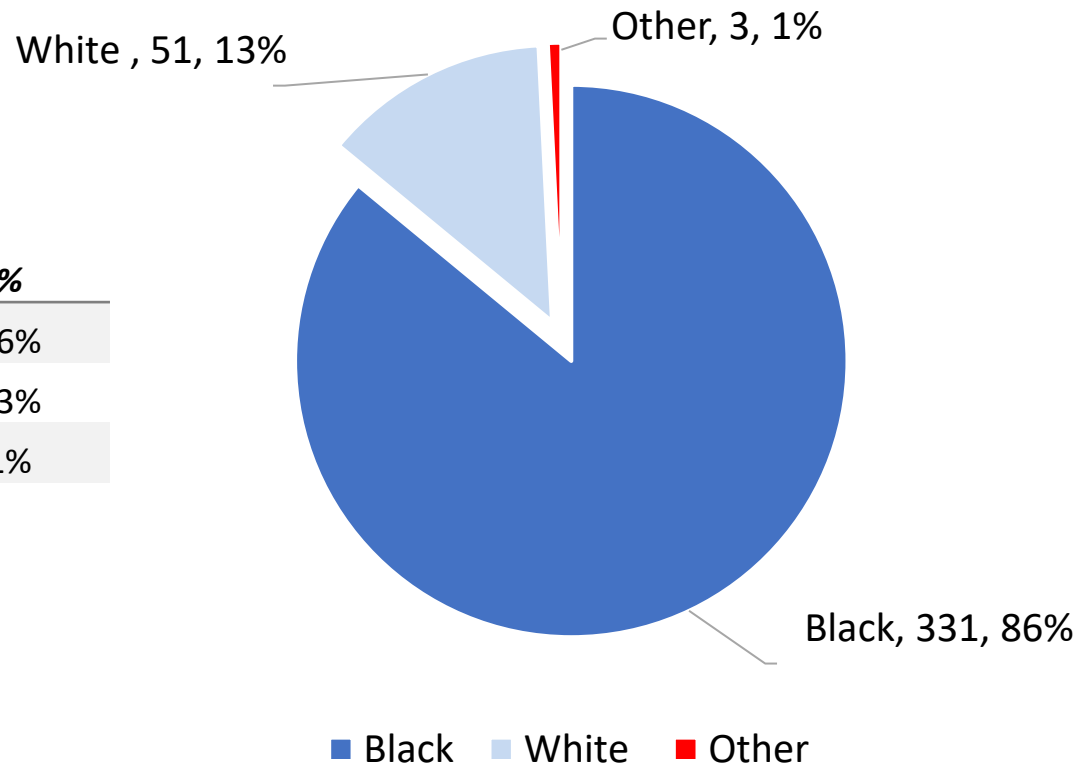

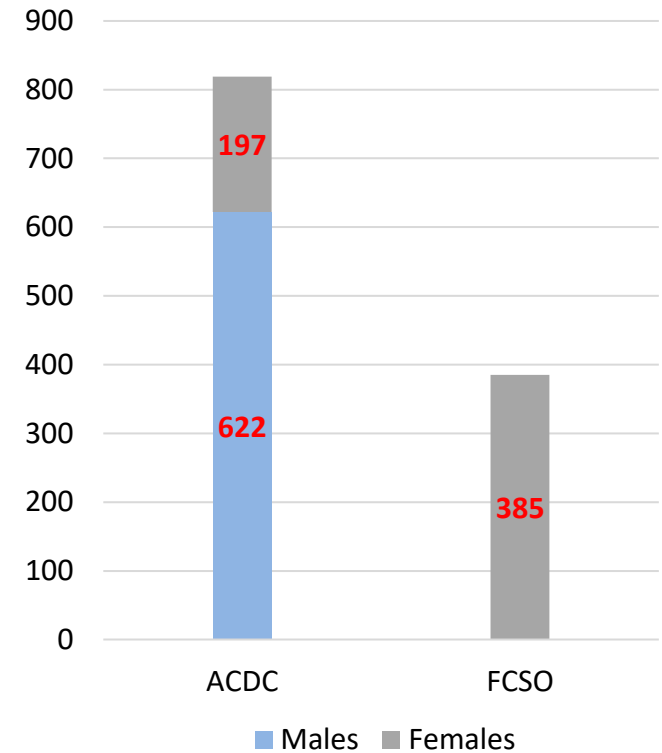

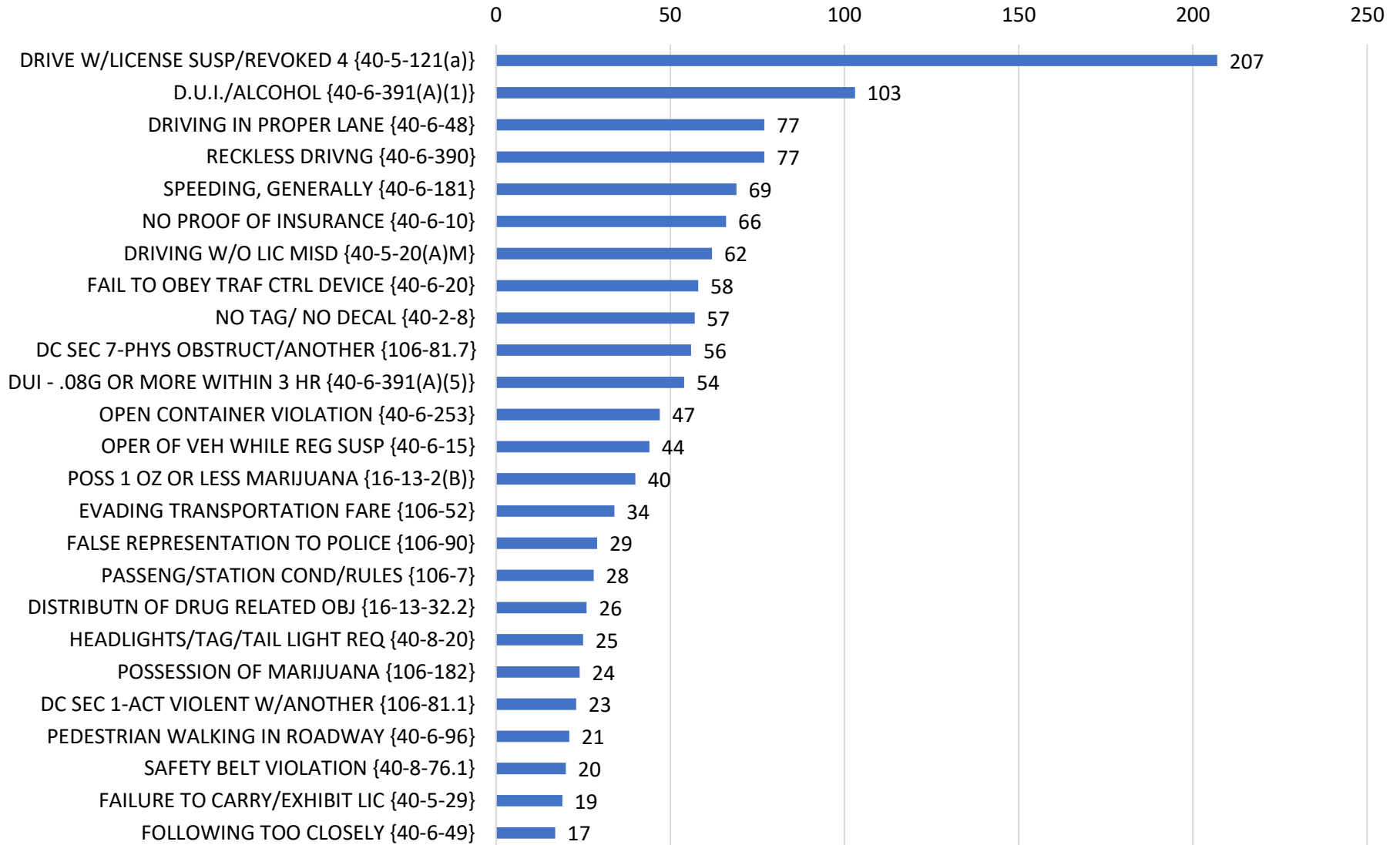
