



ACDC Statistics: Total Bookings & Average Daily Population (ADP)




2nd Quarter FY21, FY22 & FY23 Total Bookings & ADP Averages








Community Engagement Beyond the Walls of ACDC

Warming Centers Activations

- Department of Corrections (DOC) joined with several municipalities to provide a safe, clean, and warm space for the community and homeless population during extreme weather conditions in the surrounding areas in the City of Atlanta.
- DOC prepared and transported a total of 7,573 meals.
- 2,149 blankets were washed for the Warming Centers during the 2nd quarter.
- Nine (9) total activations for three (3) Warming Centers.






Pre-trial & City Fines



Demographics By Race ACDC Detainees Only December 2022



Demographics By Race FCSO Detainees Only December 2022






Demographics (Gender, Age & Average Length of Stay) ACDC and FCSO Detainees December 2022


