

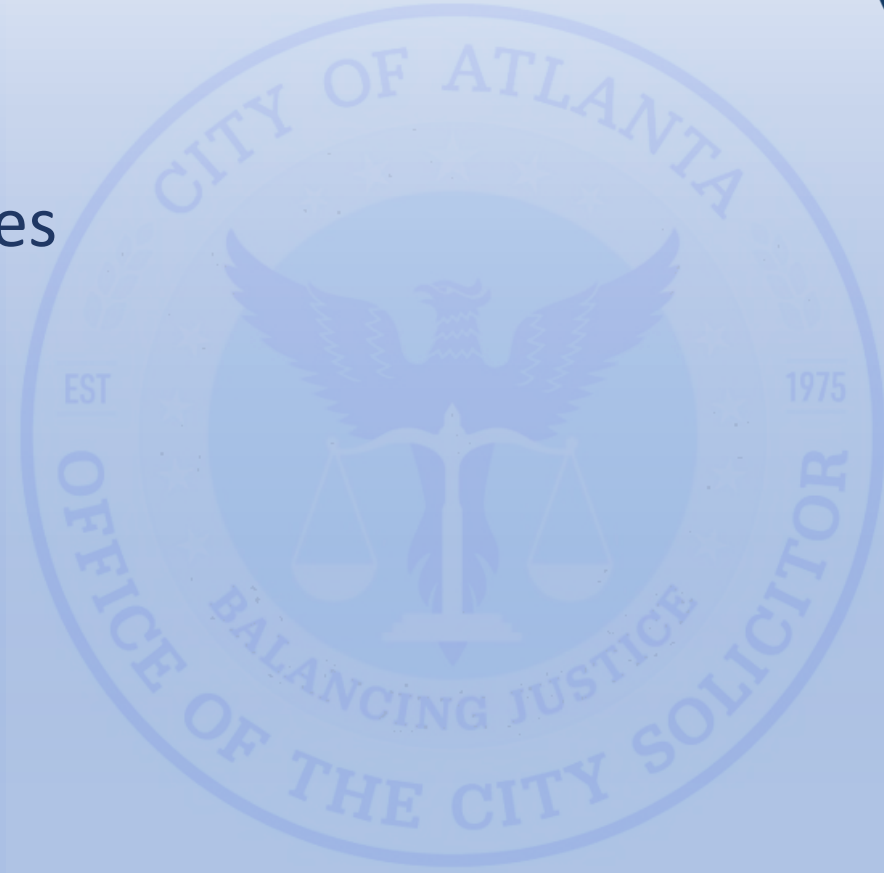
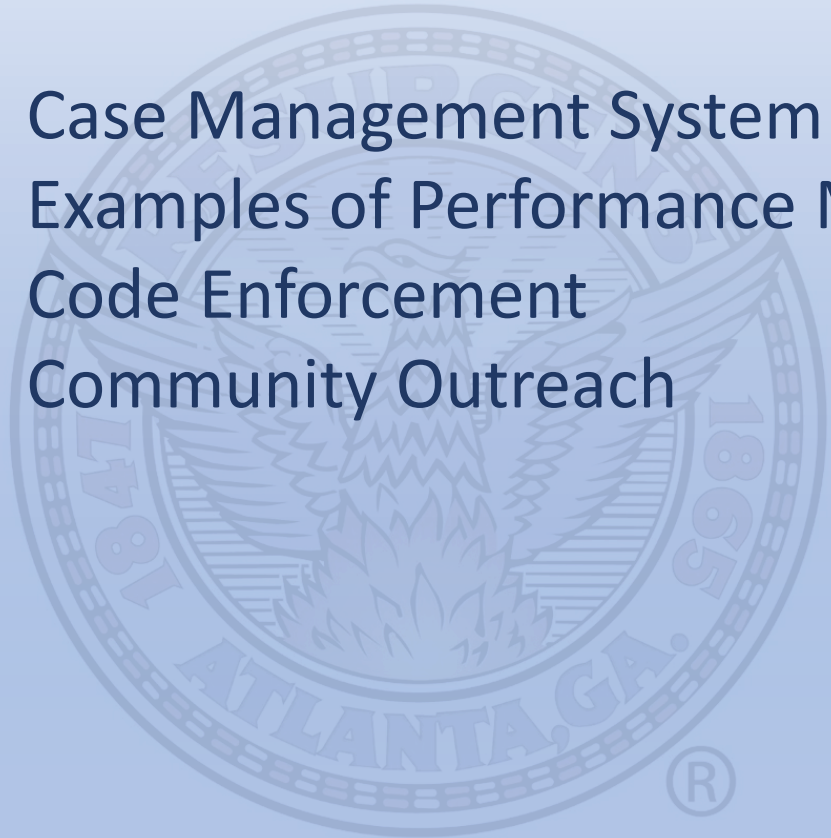

# Case Management System





## Benefits of Performance Metrics Data

- The Solicitor's Office case management system will enable the department to capture data to measure effectiveness and efficiency not only using traditional metrics such as convictions and dismissals, but also provide the ability to measure accountability, resource prioritization, community safety, and prosecutorial ethics and integrity.
- Once implemented, it will provide metrics to evaluate workloads, trends and performance.
- This data will be proven beneficial to City Administration, City Council, law enforcement agencies and the public by:
  - Leveraging technology to efficiently handle cases
  - Improving operations and evaluating staffing needs
  - Ensuring proper allocation of resources
  - Easing collaboration with other City departments and community groups
  - Promoting a safe environment
  - Ensuring proper and successful prosecution of cases



## Traditional Performance Measurement Examples

- Examples of the traditional prosecution performance metrics are valuable as they provide case dispositions, such as convictions and dismissals.
  - Successful
  - Unsuccessful
- However, successful prosecution should also be measured by how it serves the community as well as how it allows for diverse and broad discretion in managing caseloads.

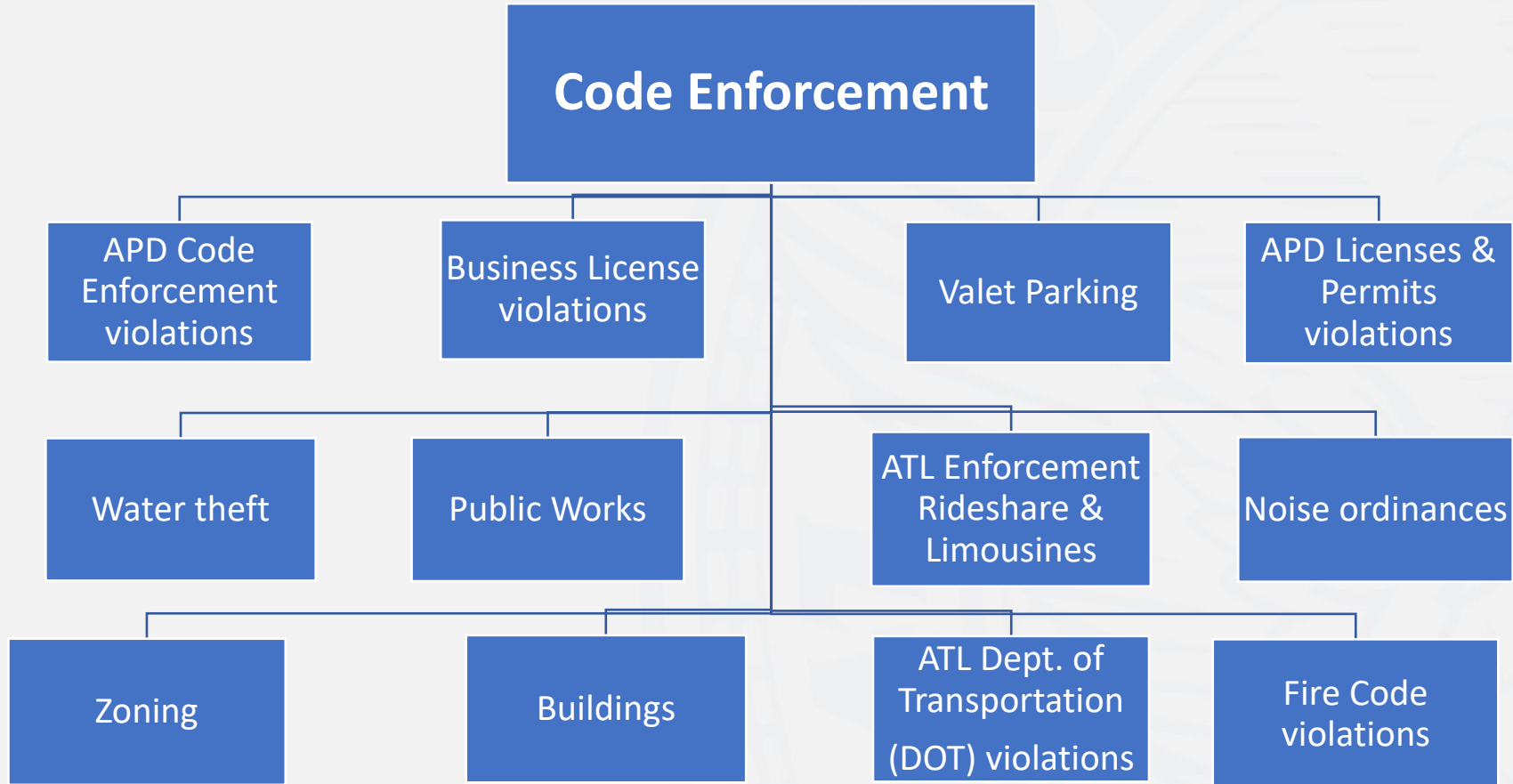

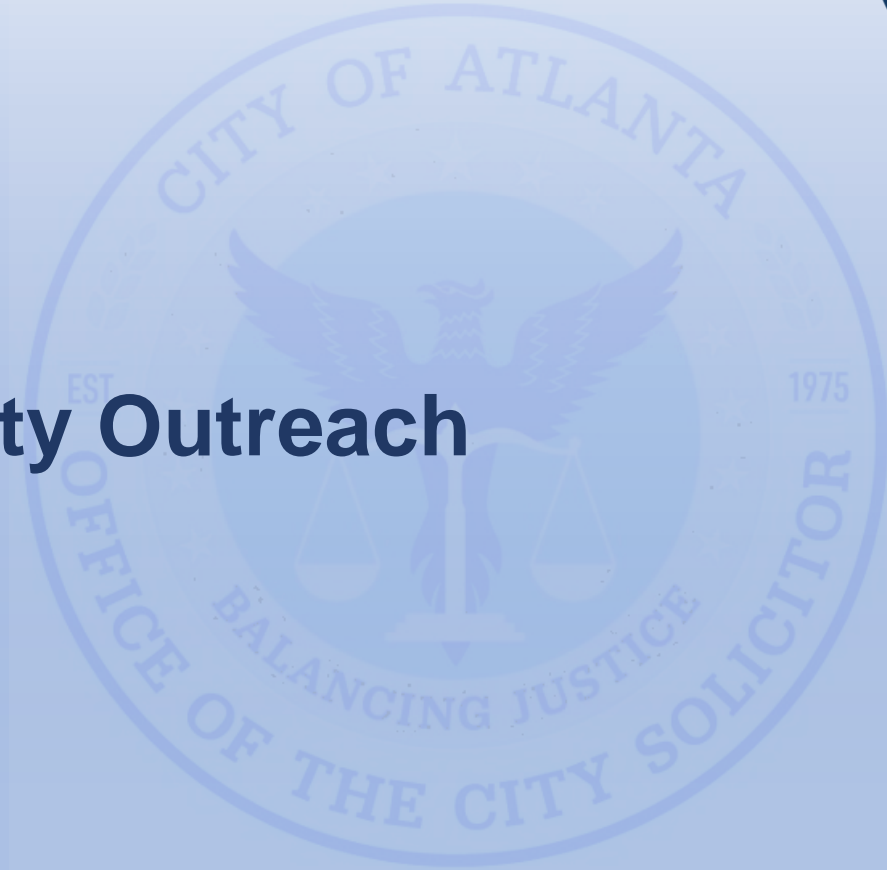
# Department of Public Works Collaboration



- The Department of Public Works, (DPW), has partnered with the Solicitor's Office to hire two sworn officers as part of a new effort focused on reducing illegal dumping across the city.
- The sworn officers, the purchase and construction of mobile surveillance cameras, and the build-out of a new command center will all work together to identify and prosecute repeat offenders.
- Mobile surveillance cameras located in known illegal dumping areas across the city will send video back to the new DPW Command Center. Employees working in the center will contact the officers to alert them of crimes in process. The video will also be used to collect information that will help officers identify violators and bring them to justice.

# Year of the Youth Initiative

*The Solicitor's Office hosted the following events:*

- On March 3, 2023, the Young Litigators Team, consisting of six attorneys, participated in a Moot Court competition with the Life School. Ms. Domineck argued an issue about freedom of speech and a school's ability to regulate off-campus speech. Ms. Domineck went up against Midtown High School's team and won the award for Best Respondent. She also received an award for being a participant in the competition for the entire 4 years of her high school career, as well as other extracurricular activities.
- On April 6, 2023, the office hosted a “Day in the Life of a prosecutor” where middle school students visited the Atlanta City Jail and the Atlanta Municipal Court. At the court, they engaged with Judge Crystal Gaines as well as public defenders and prosecutors.
- On April 26, 2023, the office hosted Youth Outreach at the YMCA on Campbellton Road. The agenda included a Young Adult Driver Safety presentation and skating.
- During March and April the office collected and donated 23 prom dresses, 10 pairs of ladies shoes, 3 tuxedos, 2 pairs of men’s dress shoes, jewelry and evening purses for the Atlanta PAL Prom Campaign.
