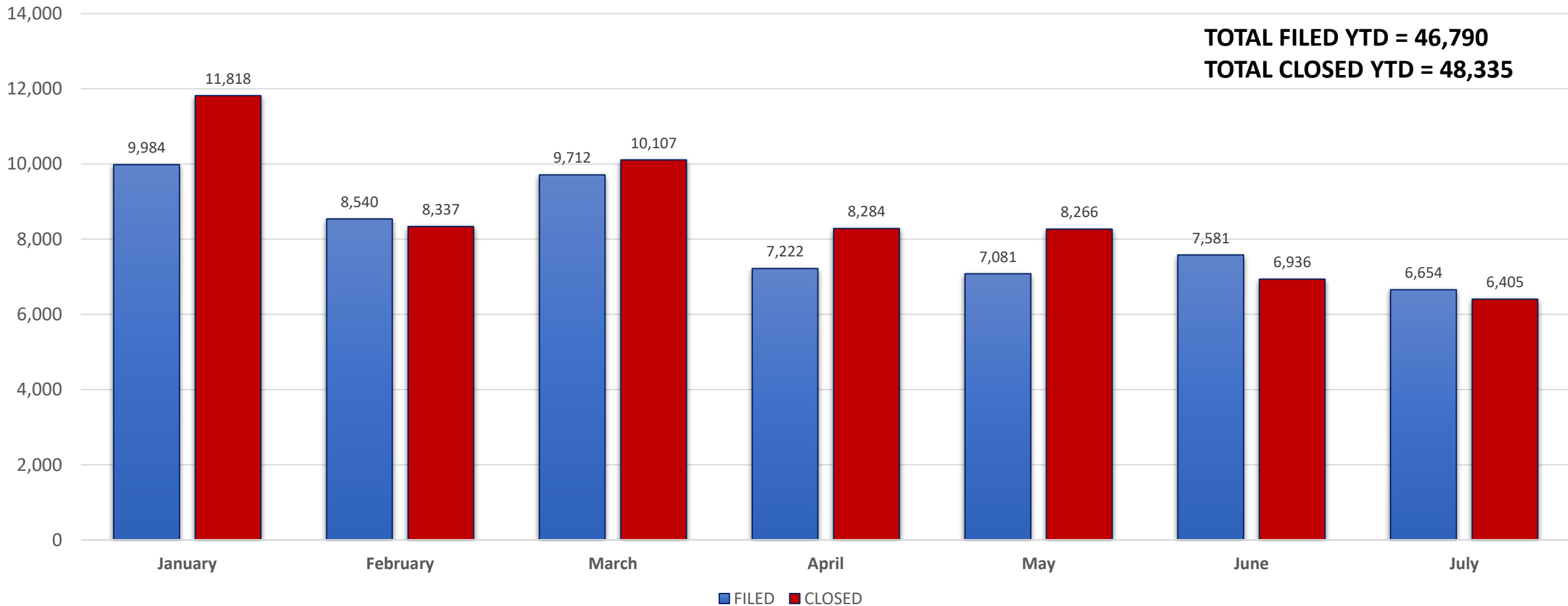

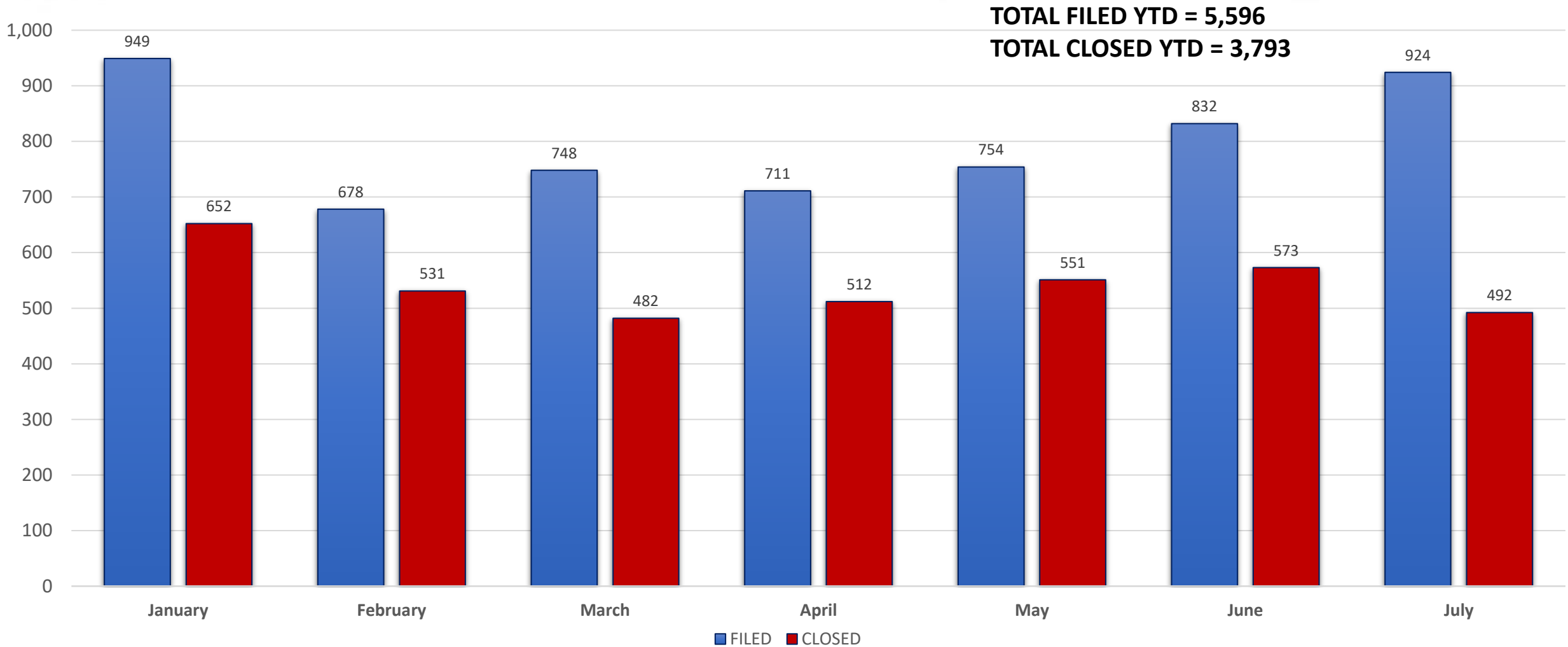


CASE METRICS: FILED vs CLOSED | TRAFFIC CASES CY2023 YTD



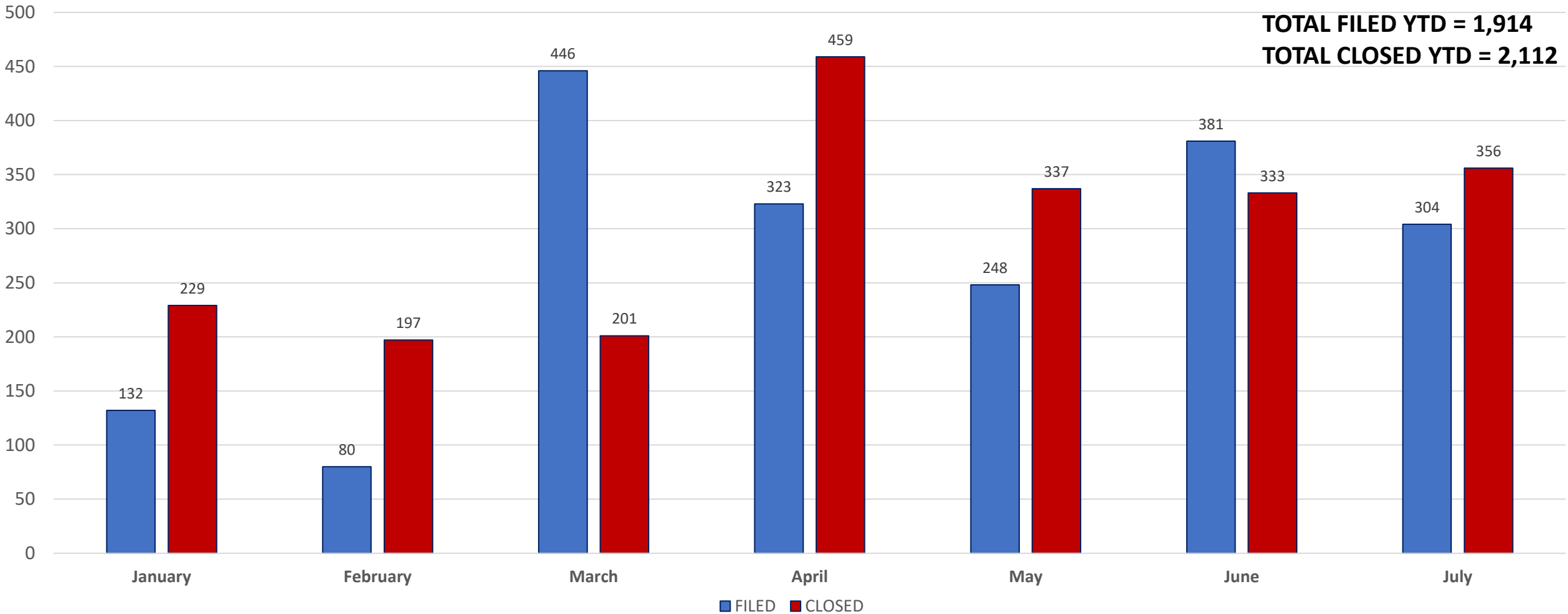


CASE METRICS: FILED vs CLOSED | CRIMINAL CASES CY2023 YTD



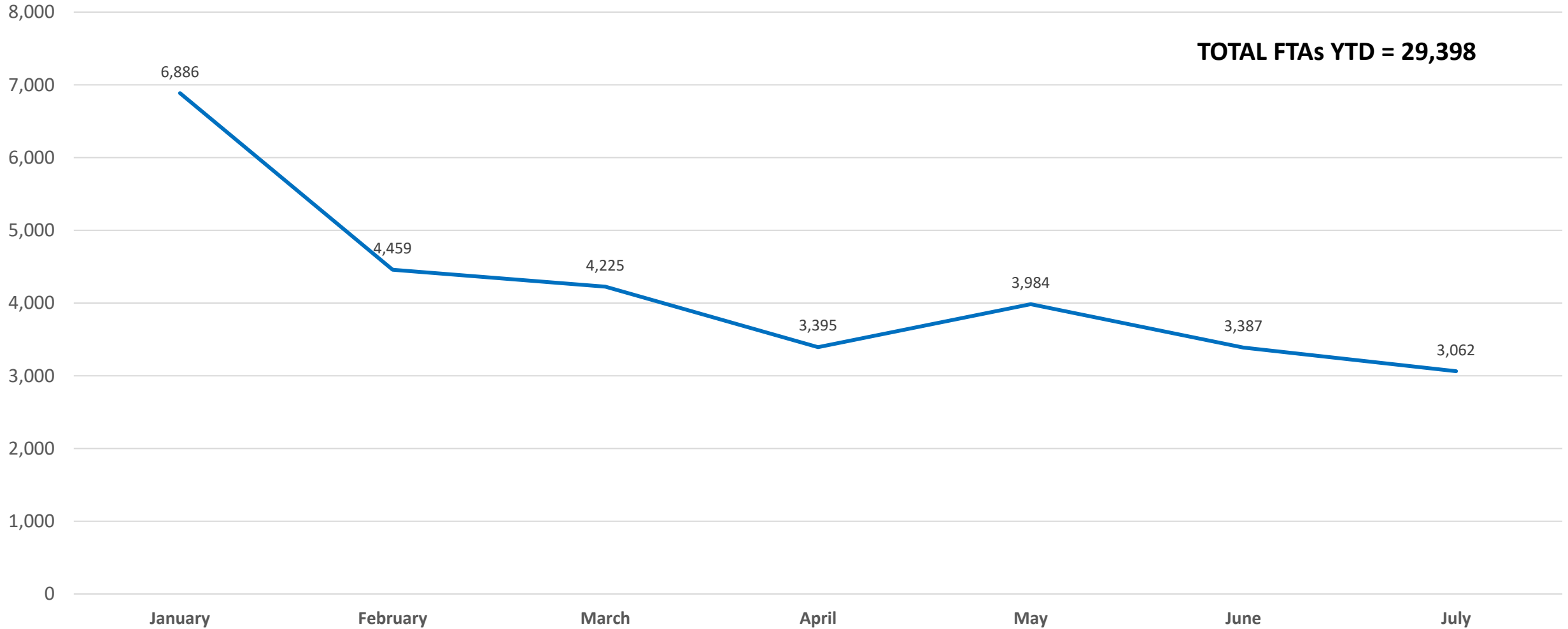


CASE METRICS: FILED vs CLOSED | HOUSING CASES CY2023 YTD



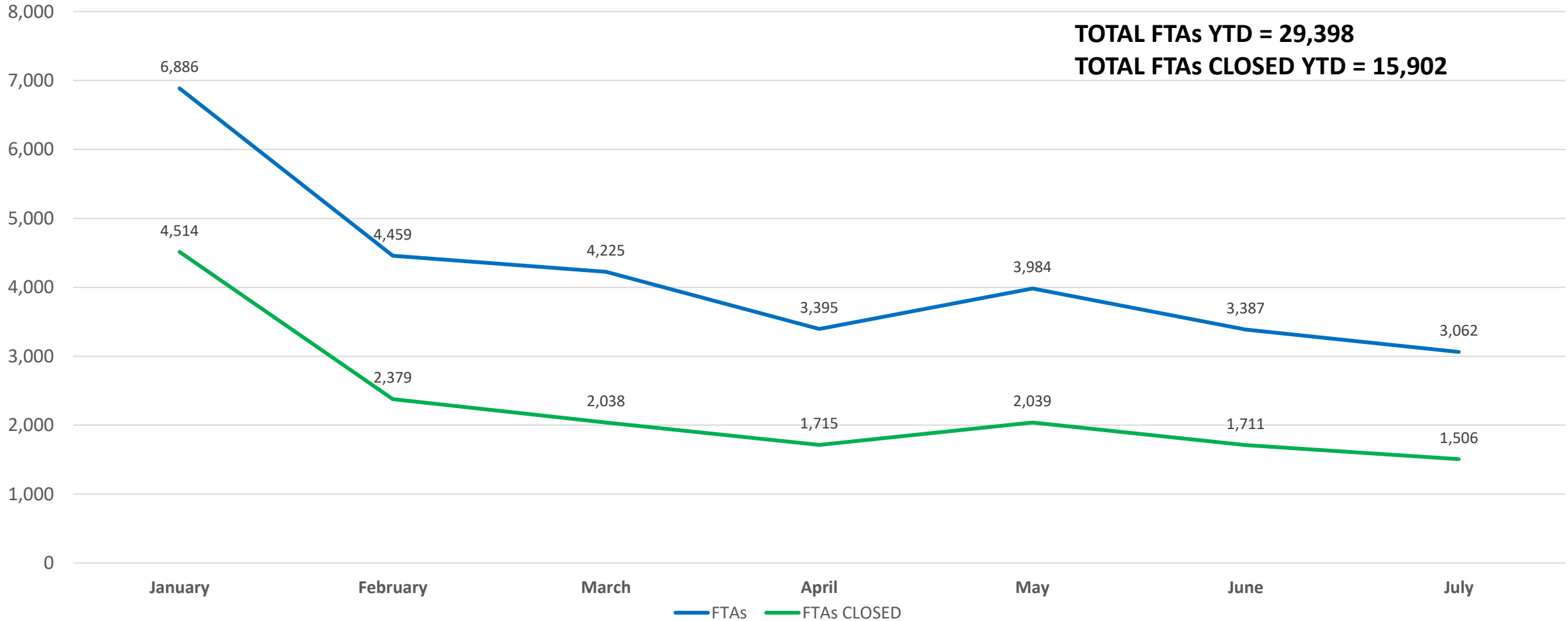


FAILURE TO APPEAR (FTA) | FTAs CY2023 YTD





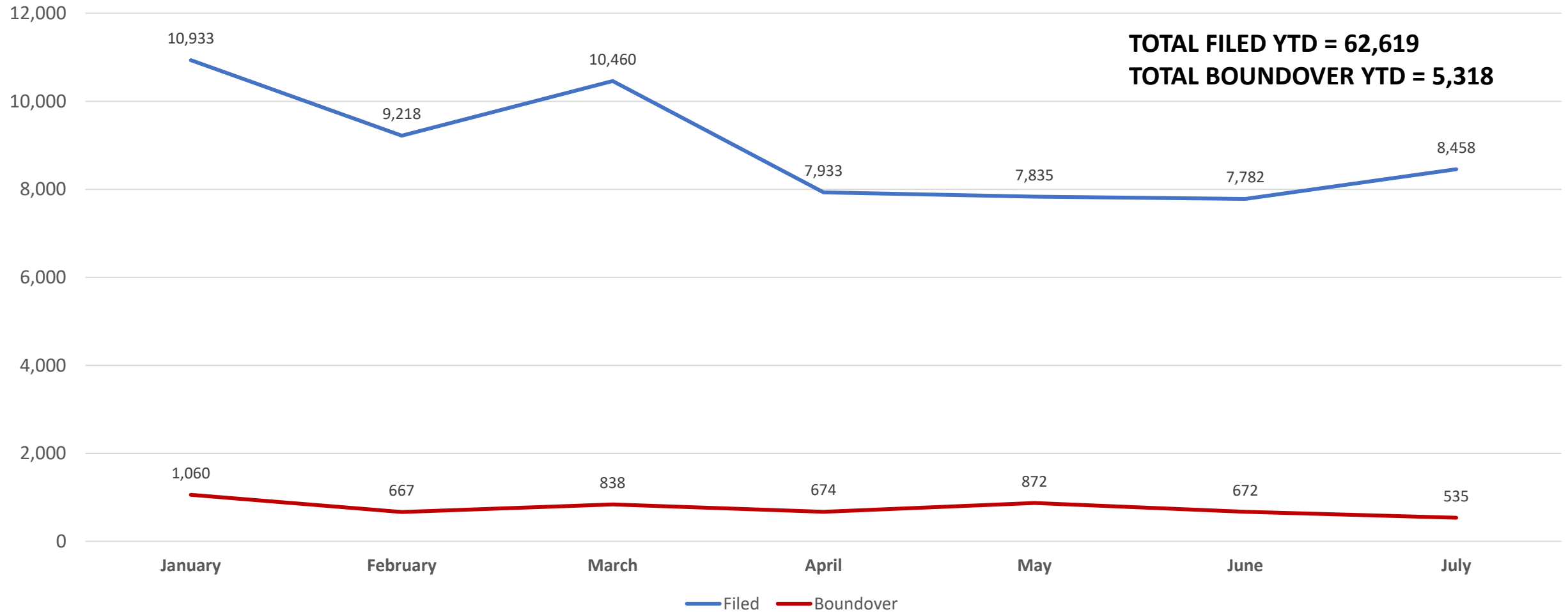
FAILURE TO APPEAR (FTA) | FTAs vs FTAs Closed CY2023 YTD





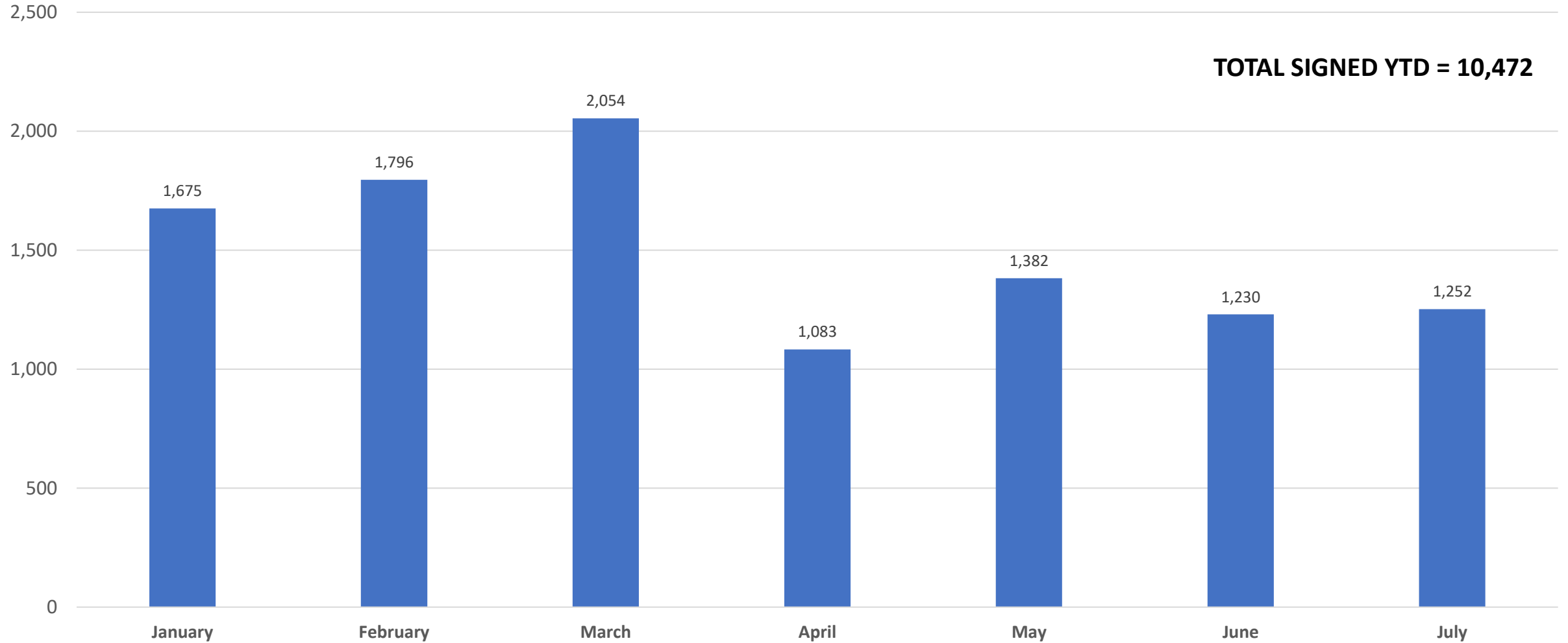

CASE METRICS: TOTAL TRAFFIC & CRIMINAL FILED vs BOUNDOVER | CY2023 YTD



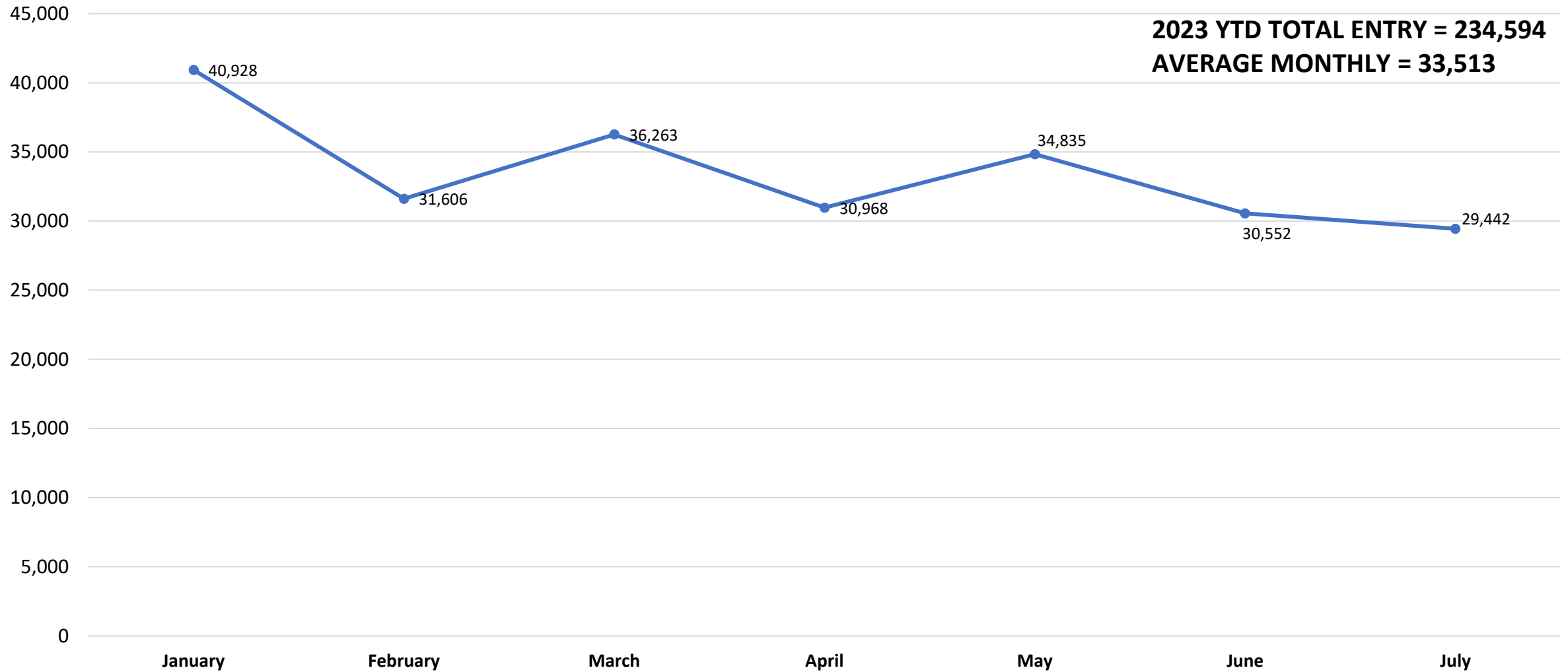


FTA WARRANTS | WARRANTS SIGNED CY2023 YTD





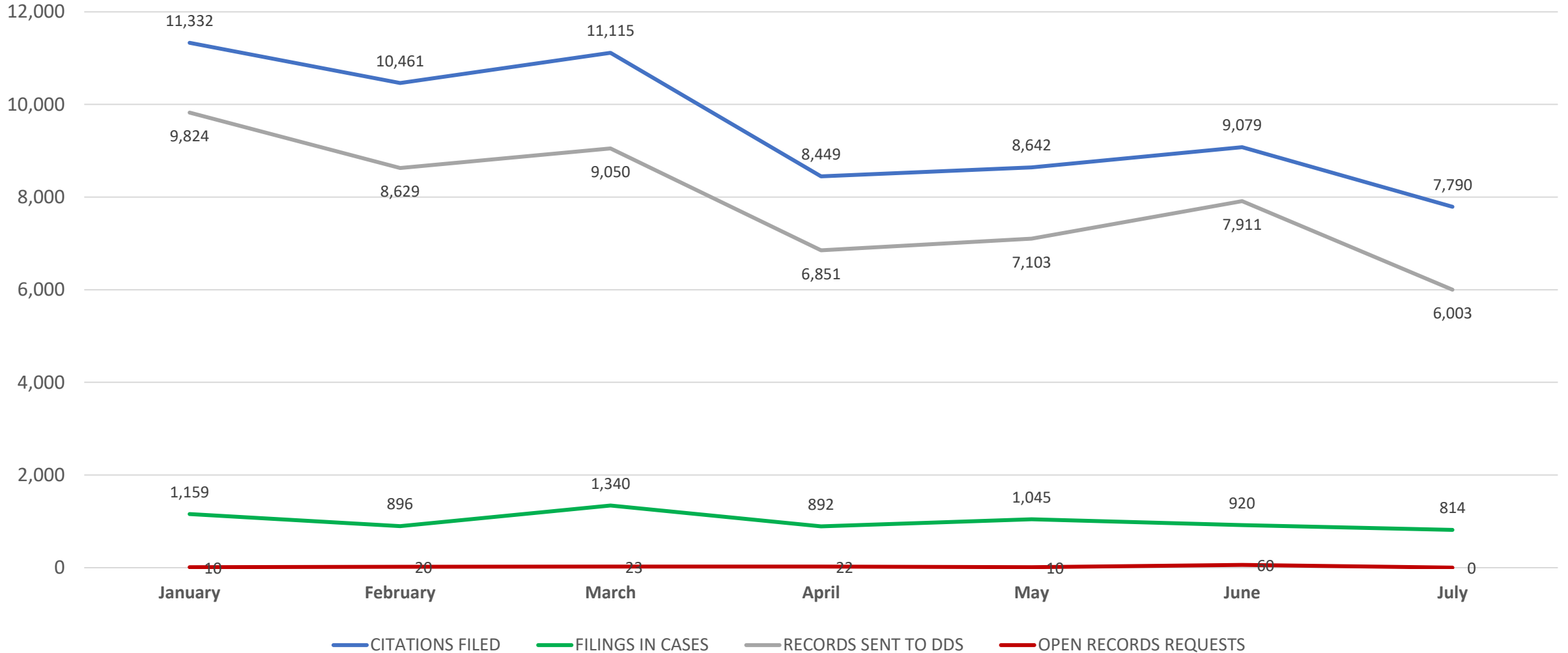
GENERAL OPERATIONS | BUILDING ENTRANCE CY2023 YTD

PROCEDURE UPDATE | SENTENCING & FINGER PRINTING

Effective September 1st, individuals given suspended sentences may be finger-printed at the time of sentencing:

- Cases where a defendant is required to serve a jail sentence that is otherwise suspended may result in fingerprinting to ensure the case result is reflected upon the individual's criminal history, specifically when the individual was not initially arrested;
- This option will be considered in cases of repeated instances of like or similar conduct, including cases that have mandatory jail sentences imposed by law;
- Examples include, but are not limited to, driving on suspended license, speeding at high rates, attempting to conceal the identity of a vehicle, shoplifting, exposure of genitals, and matters involving trespass.
