



Total Overall Cases Created vs % of Cases Resolved within SLA



SOLID WASTE SERVICES TONNAGE











DPW SOLID WASTE TONNAGE











TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SPECIAL OPS

OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA APRIL 2023 - JUNE 2023









TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SOLID WASTE April 2023 – June 2023

OVERALL % OF SOLID WASTE CASES BY SLA APRIL 2023 - JUNE 2023





Total SWEET Cases Created vs % of Cases Resolved within SLA








DPW FLEET PERFORMANCE METRICS – INTERNAL REPAIR





FLEET VEHICLES PENDING INTERNAL REPAIR






% - COMMERCIAL REPAIRS COMPLETED BY WEEK (April 2023 - June 2023)



FLEET VEHICLES PENDING COMMERCIAL ACCIDENT REPAIR






DPW TIME SPENT - BY MONTH



NUMBER OF COMPLETED REPAIRS BY DEPARTMENT





Citywide Fleet Availability






PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE MISSED VS. SCHEDULED









DPW employees received their Lean Six Sigma Green Belt certificates.




Retirement Over 41 Years of Service
