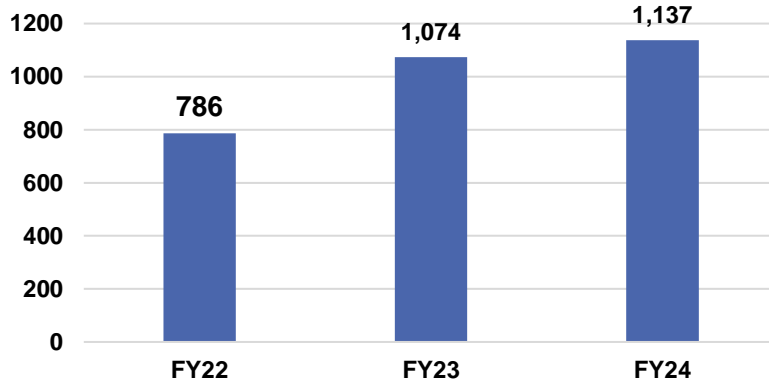

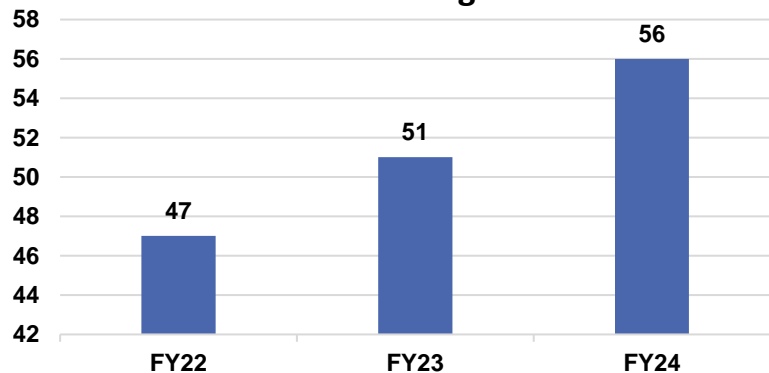
Total Bookings / Average Daily Population (ADP) Statistics

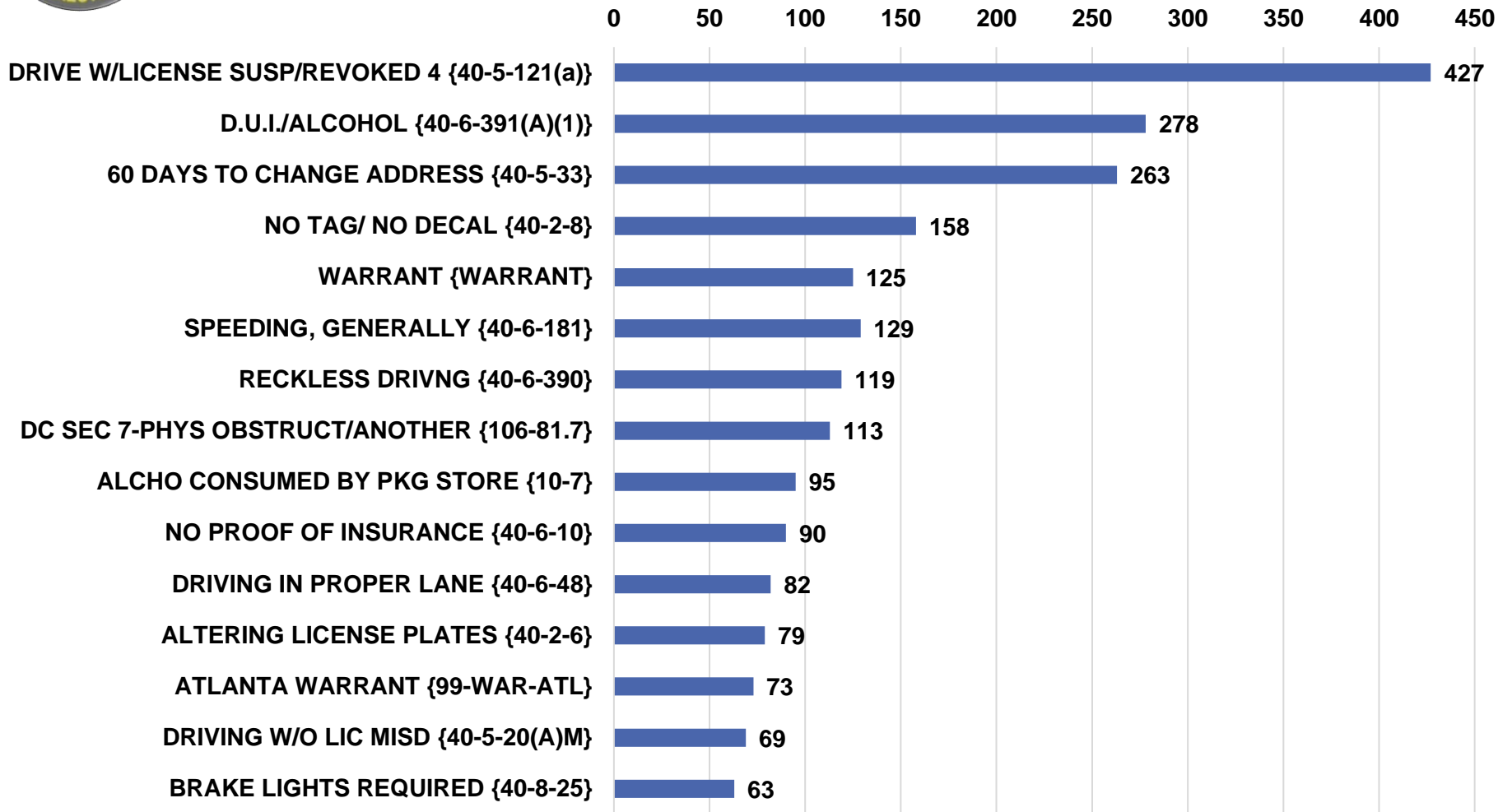

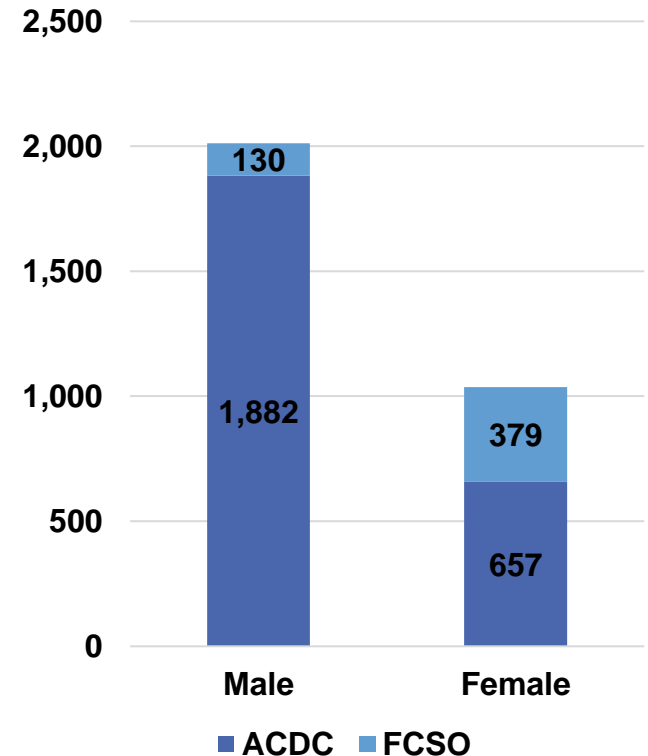

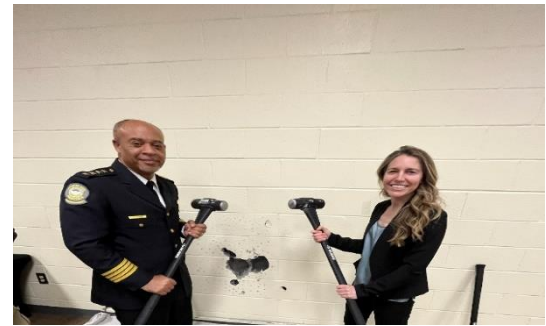
