




Centers of Hope Afterschool Program

- Currently programming at 21 sites, including partner sites
- Focus on affordability enabled through sliding scale rates based on income; over half of participants leverage sliding scale discounts

1,192 Unique Enrollees SEPT FY18






Senior Programming

- Prime Time Seniors Program launched in 2015.

The Department of Parks and Recreation performance metrics reflect the departments level of service delivered


2,500+ acres maintained (mowing, trimming, and litter) every 10 days; target 90% completed on schedule

30K+ park garbage bins emptied




every 30 days; target 100% of all bins collected on schedule with multiple pick-ups for high traffic areas







Golf Operations

- Since November 2016, took on management of four cityowned Golf Courses totaling 482 acres and including Chastain, Browns Mill, Tup Holmes, and Candler Park
- Total FY18 rounds of golf: 111,319
- The first 3 months of FY19 total rounds have increased 25% compared to the first 3 month of FY18 totaling 41,124 rounds

HIGH-LEVEL PROJECT SCHEDULE*

Timeframe	Action Item
March to November 2018	Site conditions, Geotechnical Study, and Environmental Testing
September 2018 to Fall 2019	Community Engagement, Design Planning, and Permitting
Fall 2019 to Summer 2020	Phase IA Construction (trails, parking, North Entry Gateway)
January to Winter 2020	Phase IB Construction (grading of Elevated Passive Green Meadow, signage + security)
