



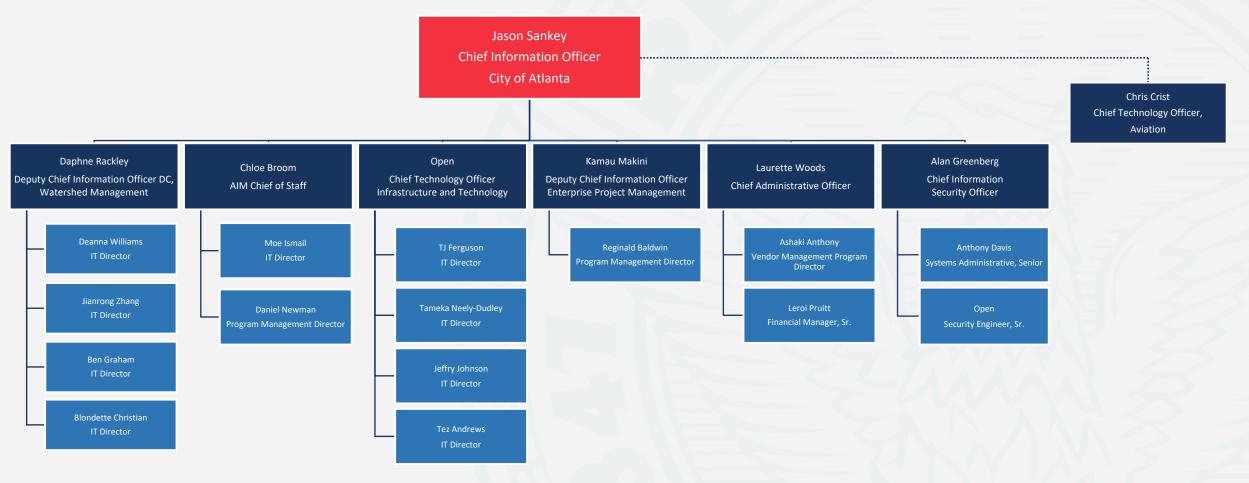

FY2025 Year in Review and Look Ahead



Accomplishments (FY24 and/or CY23)

- 1. Effective and Ethical Government: because of infrastructure modernization and application optimization, AIM realized \$2 million in savings.
- 2. A City of Opportunity for All: with the expansion of IKE kiosks throughout the City, providing access to services and offering free Wi-Fi, AIM realized incoming revenue of approximately \$1.5 million.
- 3. A City Built for the Future: upgraded critical and citizen-facing applications for enhanced technology and operations efficiencies (e.g., ATL311 enhancements).
- 4. One Safe City: partnered with public safety to enhance technology and support expansion of existing technology (e.g., MDT rollout for new vehicles).

FY25 What's New and Improved

- 1. Effective and Ethical Government: simplification of application portfolio by eliminating redundancy and retiring ineffective systems.
- 2. A City Built of Opportunity for All: implementation of a modern and fully integrated customer relationship management system.
- 3. A City Built for the Future: implementation of multiple AI tools to realize efficiencies both internally and externally.
- 4. One Safe City: in partnership with APD, realize multiple technology enhancements to ensure the resiliency of E911 operations.
