

#### Airport - Auto Theft Issues – Key Programmers



- Airport is experiencing <u>Dodge and GM products</u> <u>being stolen</u>, most likely via Key Programmers.
   There are usually never any glass breaks or keys left in the stolen vehicles.
- Using locksmith key programmers and blank keys, suspects can steal vehicles without relying on obtaining the key from the owner.
- Stellantis made vehicles (Dodge, Jeep, RAM) have been the primary target. However, thieves have been confirmed to have used this method on GM made vehicles (Chevy, Cadillac, and GMC) and others.
- Often stolen vehicles tailgate their partner vehicle out through the gates because the camera can only take a picture of the first vehicle, as it only takes one picture per security arm raise.


