Situational Overview

- May 31, 2024, Joseph E. Boone Blvd and James P. Brawley Dr.
- The water main break near the intersection of Joseph E Boone Blvd NW and J.P. Brawley Dr.
- Crews were onsite and working aggressively to repair the 48-inch and 36-inch transmission lines.
- May 31, 2024, West Peachtree St. and 11th St.
- The water main break near the intersection of West Peachtree St. and 11th St.





What's Next

- The Department of Watershed Management is reviewing the resolution introduced by the Atlanta City Council to aid residents and businesses affected by the two water main breaks that occurred on May 31, 2024.
- DWM conducting a comprehensive review of customers systemwide and is committed to delivering superior customer service.
- The Department of Watershed Management is not currently finding extensive water pressure issues across the city of Atlanta. However, we are actively collaborating with local businesses and residents to offer any potential assistance.
