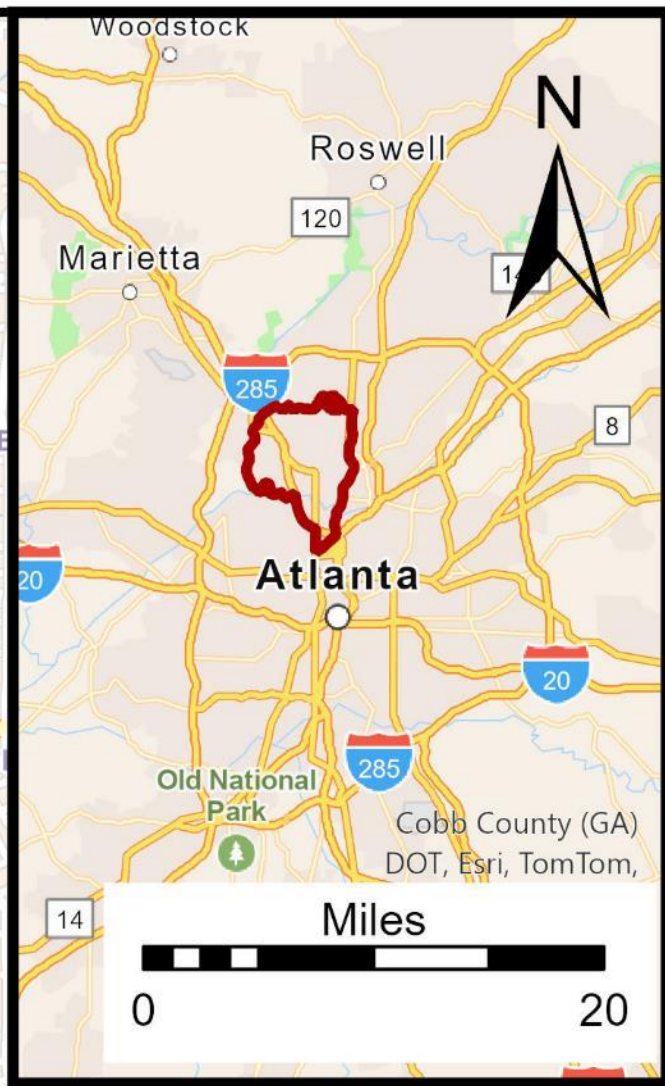
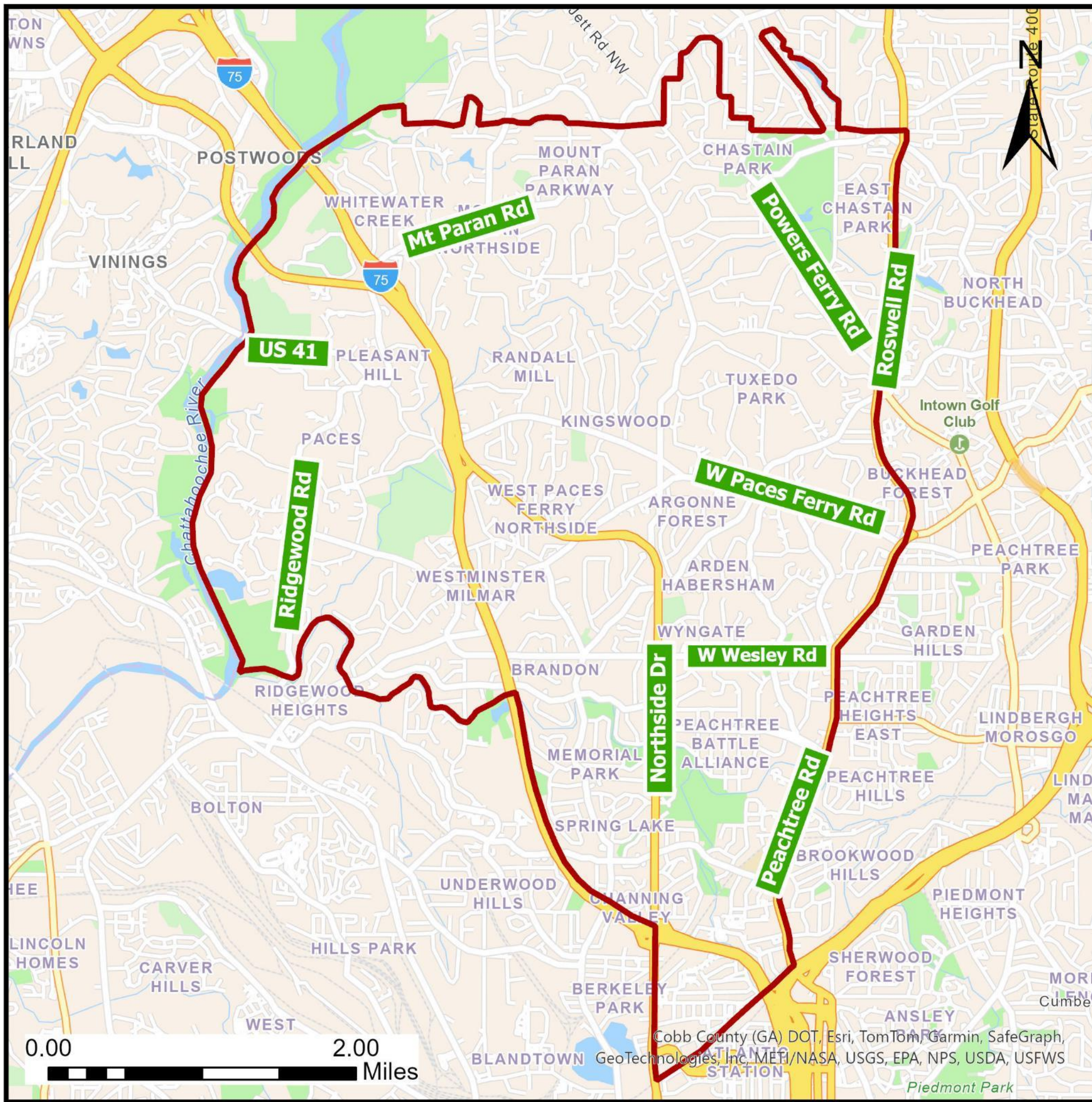

Safety



- Vision Zero is a systems-based approach to eliminating traffic fatalities and serious injuries through:
 - safer street design
 - speed management
 - other proven strategies
- In April 2020, the City of Atlanta solidified this commitment by passing the Vision Zero ordinance, 20-O-1239, requiring a Vision Zero Action Plan and authorizing a 25 mph default speed limit on many city streets.
- With the support of the Atlanta Regional Commission and over 35 stakeholder agencies, ATLDOT completed the Vision Zero Action Plan in November 2023, with a goal of meeting Vision Zero by the year 2040.

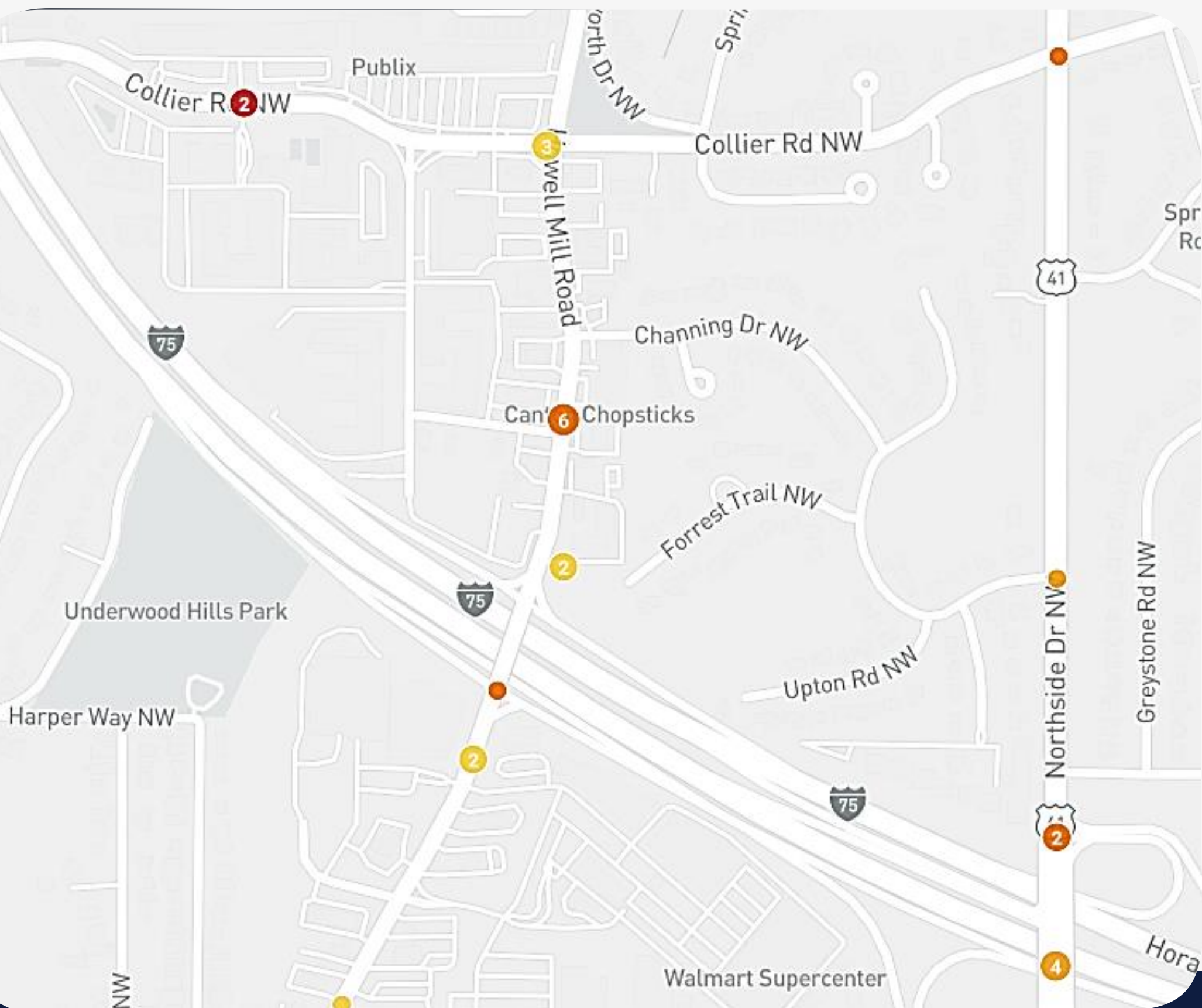
Issue: Cracked sidewalk; no curb between sidewalk and roadway

Location: South side of bridge over railroad; East side of Peachtree Rd.



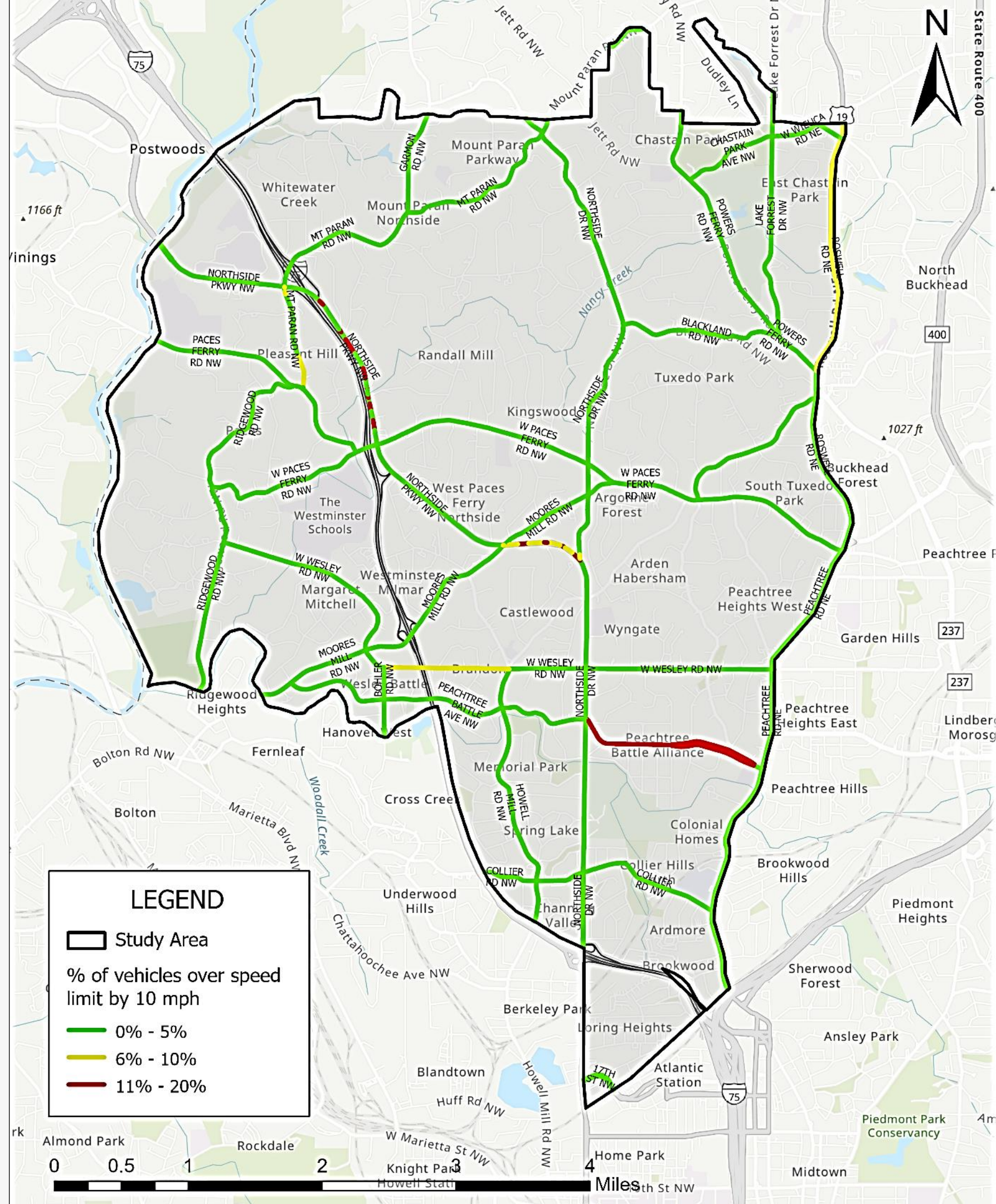
Issue: Cracked sidewalk; no curb between sidewalk and roadway

Location: North side of bridge over railroad. East side of Peachtree Rd.



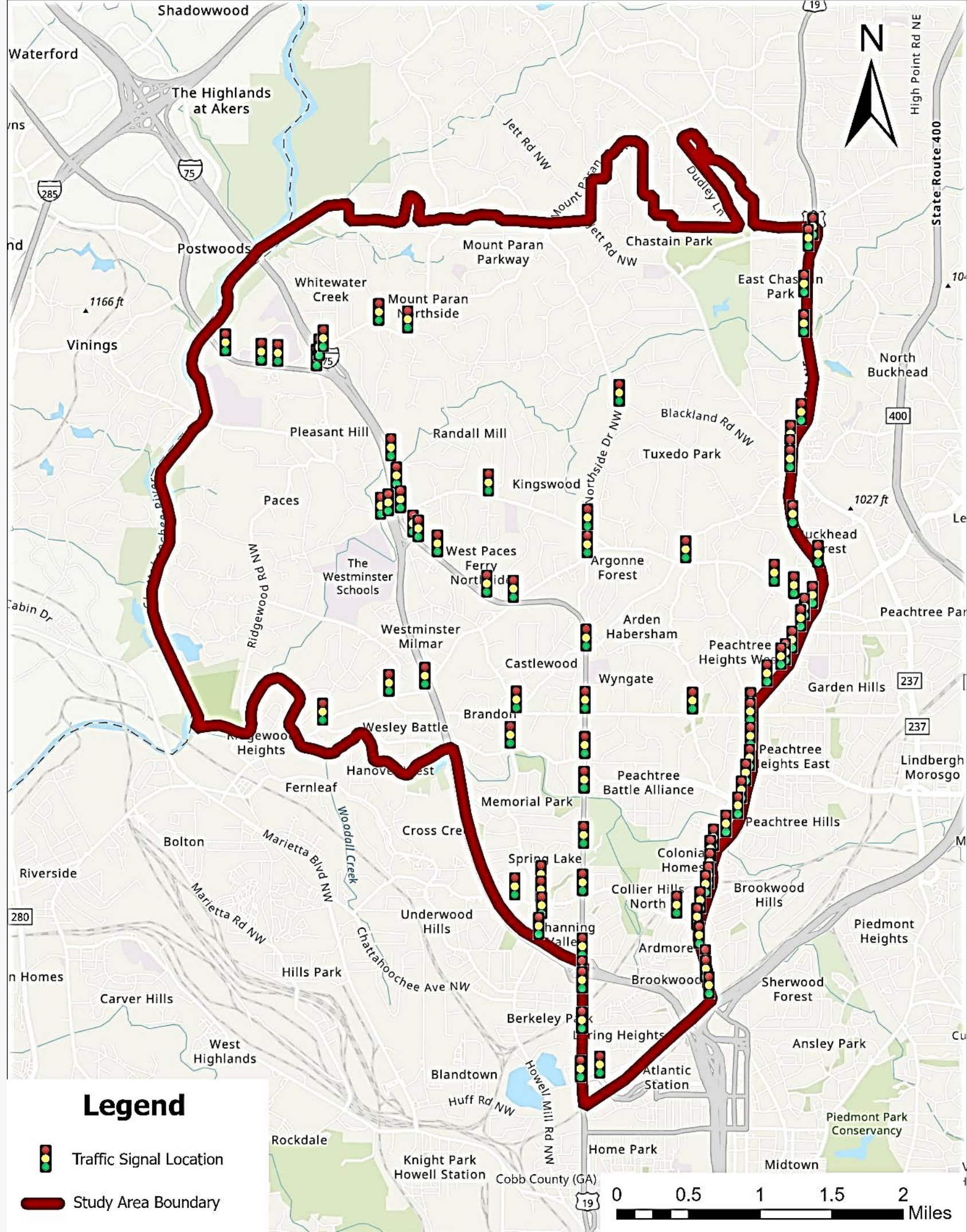
VRU Crashes near Collier Rd and Howell Mill Rd

Speeds by percentage of vehicles over the speed limit

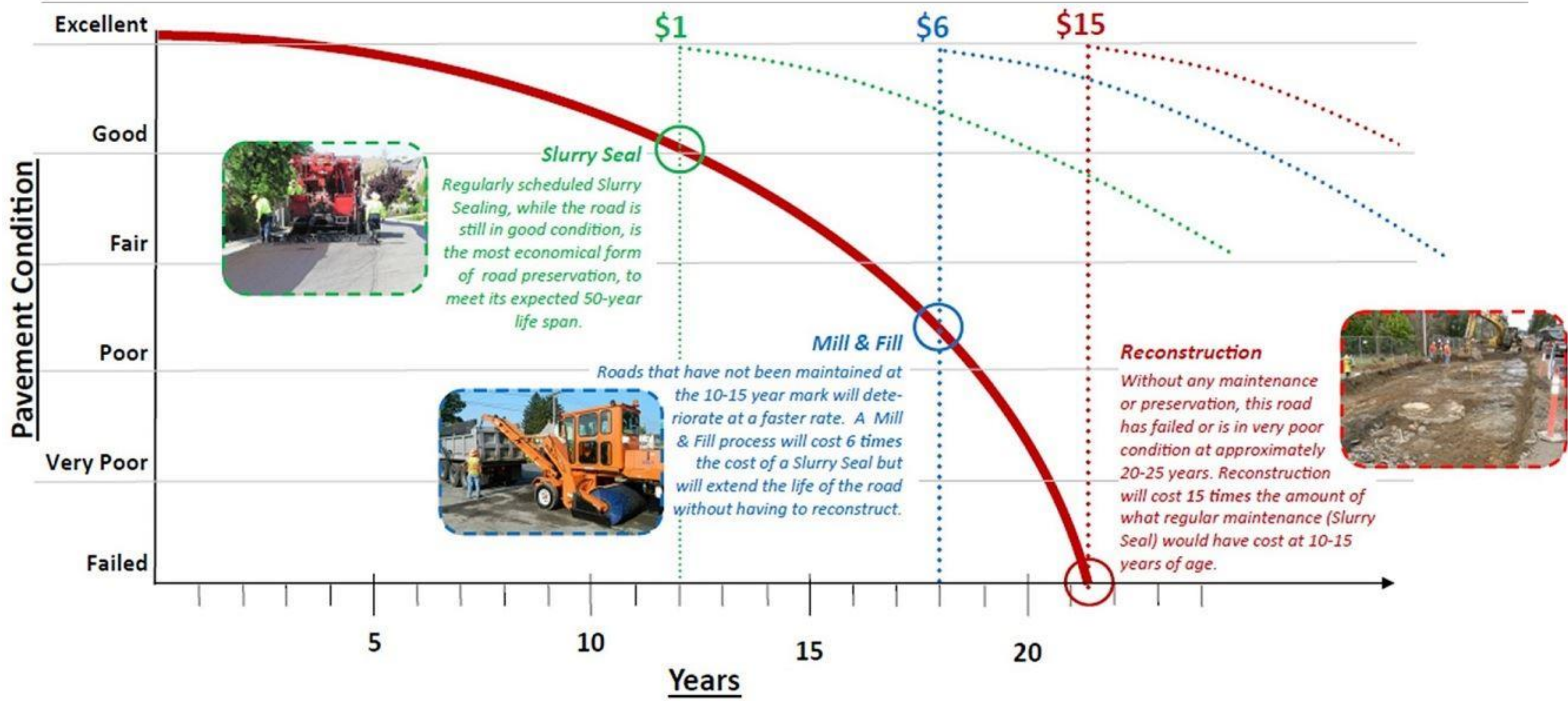
- Daily speeds

- Nearly 90 stop-and-go traffic signals in the study area
- 60 of those are on SR 3 and SR 9
