- Discussion about Complete Streets – what are they, how many in District 8
 - Help with mobility measures outside of vehicle travel
 - Sidewalks / signals/crosswalks/bike lanes / striping/transit/trails
- Discussion about how speed is calculated for heat maps
 - Uses cell anonymous cell phone data
- Discussion about how traffic signals are timed and serviced
 - Sometimes the best info is from residents calling 311
 - Adjustments can include internal timer settings
- GDOT spoke about which roads are state routes, how they do vegetation removal, manage construction and are big on complete streets projects and multi model
 - Spoke about future projects at 75 northbound ramp and Moores Mill
 - Discussion is between city and GDOT (signal vs. roundabout)

- Discussion on future improvements to I-75 ramps at Northside
- 2027 – estimate for replacement of Howell Mill/Peachtree Battle bridge
- 2029 – replace Peachtree bridge at Piedmont/Shepherd
 - Bridge replacement will include allowance for Beltline underpass
- Discussion on design/ plan for Deering Road sidewalk from Standish to Peachtree
 - Not sure of details
