Discussion points:

Streets – volume of traffic not always cause of the street deterioration (it can be water infiltration and construction

Can we use slurry as temporary measure to extend life of road instead of waiting until total rebuild is required

How can we track the condition of streets as well as sidewalks

Initial presentation showed crash data on streets to show where it was the worst

Question about gating a public street – this is not legal. Only option is for residents to purchase the street, then must maintain it.

Idea – construction projects need to have a parking plan for construction workers (off site, shuttle, etc)

Can Comprehensive Development Plan include review of traffic capacity. Increase in population and density brings more car traffic and kids going to schools – can we stop subdivisions and tie increase in population to caps on private schools enrollment?

Can permitting for building include information on how it will affect traffic?

How do parks play into traffic review? How to make it safer to access parks?

Discussion about if traffic calming can include roundabouts/speed tables/chicanes/ instead of a stop sign

Previously, GDOT used to reimburse local municipalities for asphalt, but not milling or striping, or safety improvements

How can we do a checklist for doing street resurfacing – sometimes ADA ramps are not done, curbs not replaced correctly, safety items are not included

Question about plan for Moores Mill/Howell Mil intersection improvements

Discussion about the city/state Transportation Plan to come after CDP
