



## City of Atlanta Recovery Fund for Small Businesses




- Grants to eligible small businesses to support Atlanta's communities, trade, industry and commerce.
- As this is a unique situation in which the City has declared a state of emergency, these grants are to help small businesses recover from the disruption in water service.
- Businesses located in the boil water advisory impact area are eligible to apply for a grant.



#### Revenue brackets are recommended as follows:

- < \$500,000
- **\$500,000 \$1,000,000**
- **>** \$1,000,000

#### Combined, we have the following structure:

- Closed/Impacted 1-3 days, revenue < \$500,000 ~ \$2,000</li>
- Closed/Impacted 1-3 days, revenue \$500,000 \$1,000,000 ~ \$4,000
- Closed/Impacted 1-3 days, revenue > \$1,000,000 ~ \$5,000
- Closed/Impacted 4+ days, revenue < \$500,000 ~ \$6,000</li>
- Closed/Impacted 4+ days, revenue \$500,000 \$1,000,000 ~ \$8,000
- Closed/Impacted 4+ days, revenue > \$1,000,000 ~ \$10,000
