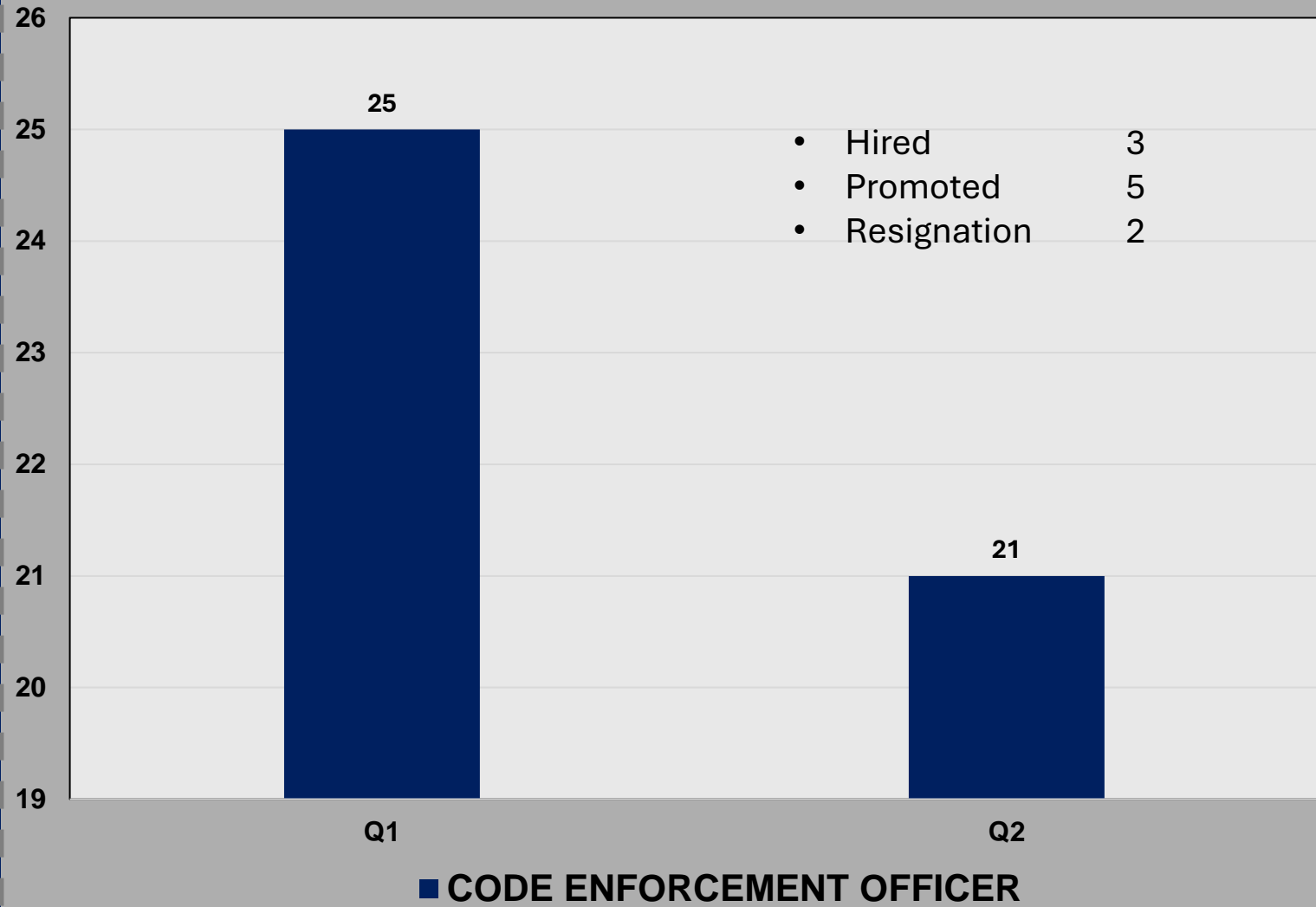

## Vehicle Distribution 12 Ford Mavericks Assigned

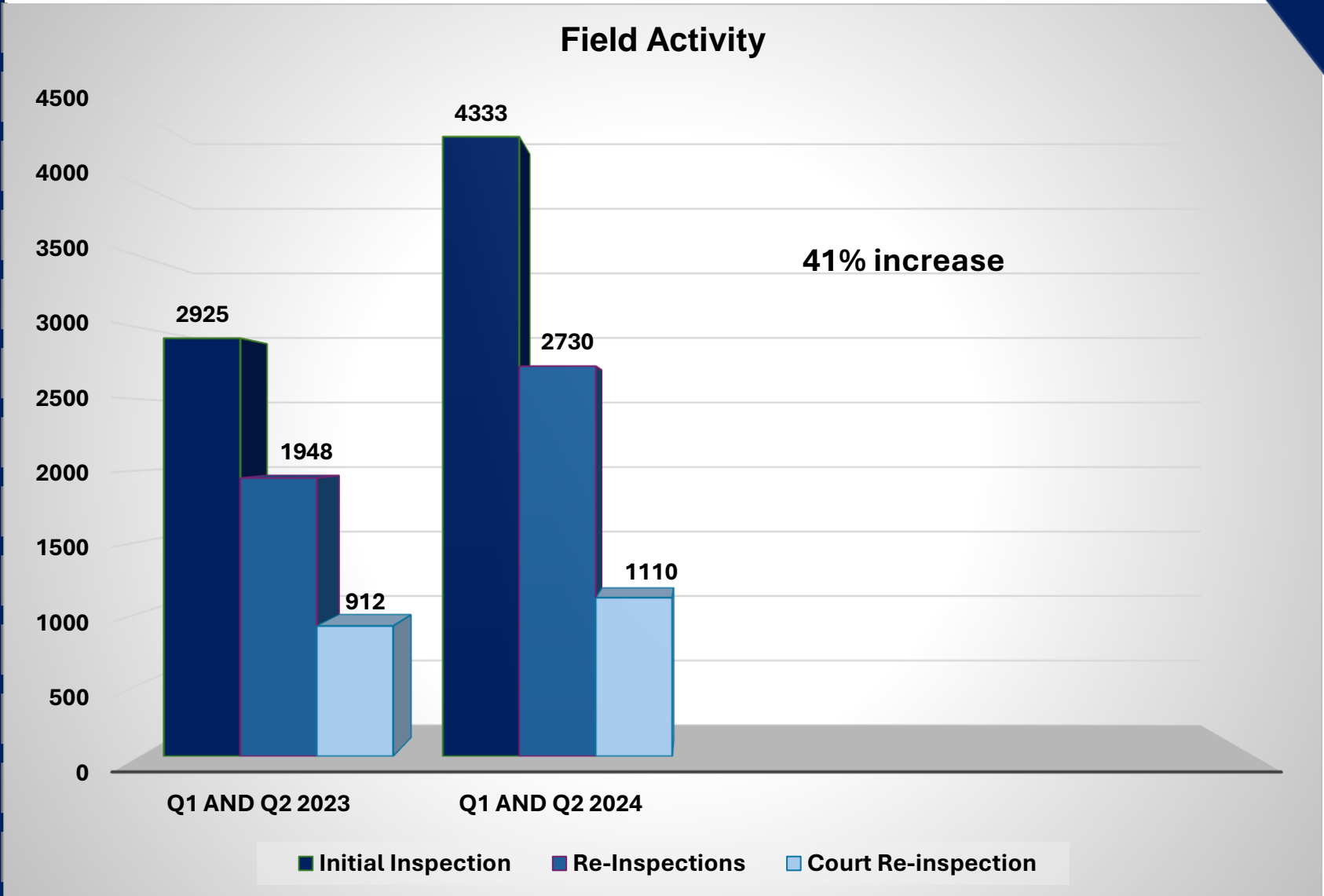

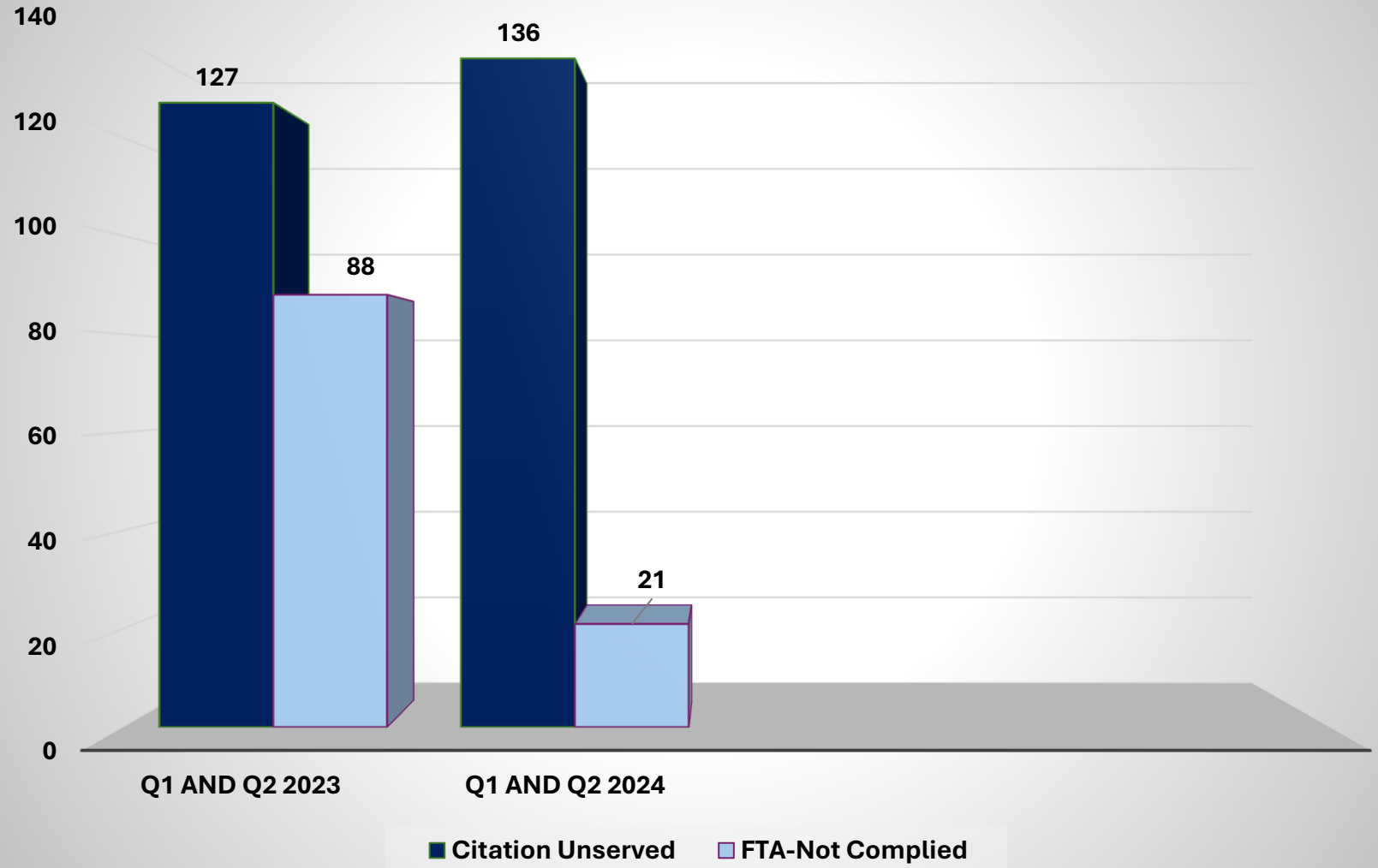

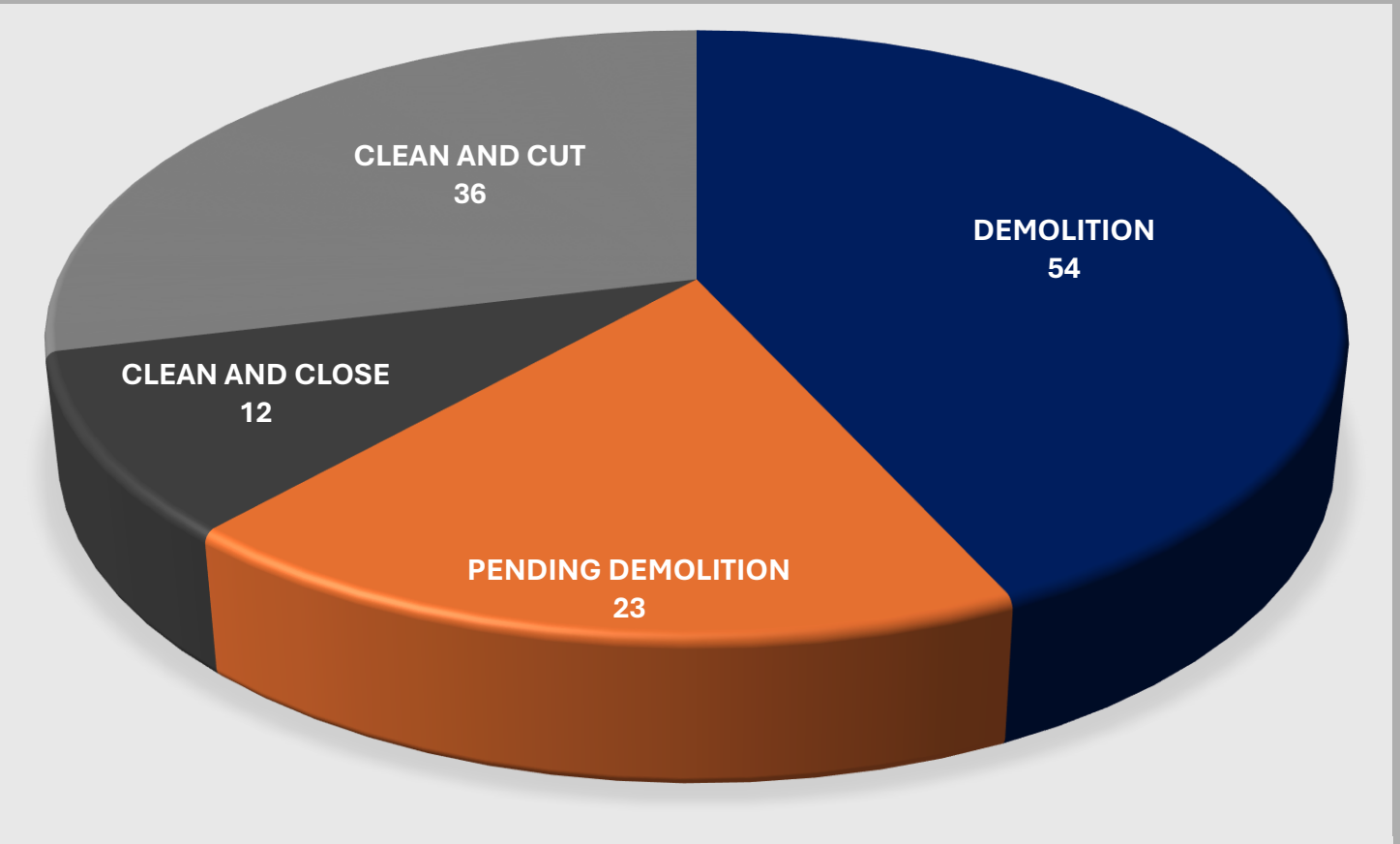

## SAFE and SECURE HOUSING INITIATIVE



ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Dedicated APD Code Enforcement team to inspect multifamily properties
- Team consists of a:
  - Project Manager
  - 3 Code Enforcement Officers
- Conducted 34 multifamily details since August 2022
  - Over 3,000 violations found
  - Over 1,000 violations complied
- Reduced time between re-inspection and court scheduling by 50%
- Monthly meeting with the Office of the City Solicitor to ensure efficiency

## **PURPOSE**

To ensure that every City of Atlanta citizen and visitor have access to safe, reliable, clean taxicabs, and other vehicles for hire and that every customer is treated with courtesy, dignity, and genuine hospitality.

## **HISTORY**

- Customer Services Unit transferred to APD Code Enforcement Section in July 2022
- No enforcement activity under Section 162 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances in the downtown area since 2017
  - No random inspections of taxicabs and animal-drawn vehicles
  - Limited investigation of complaints filed by citizens and visitors
  - Blatant violations of Section 162 missed

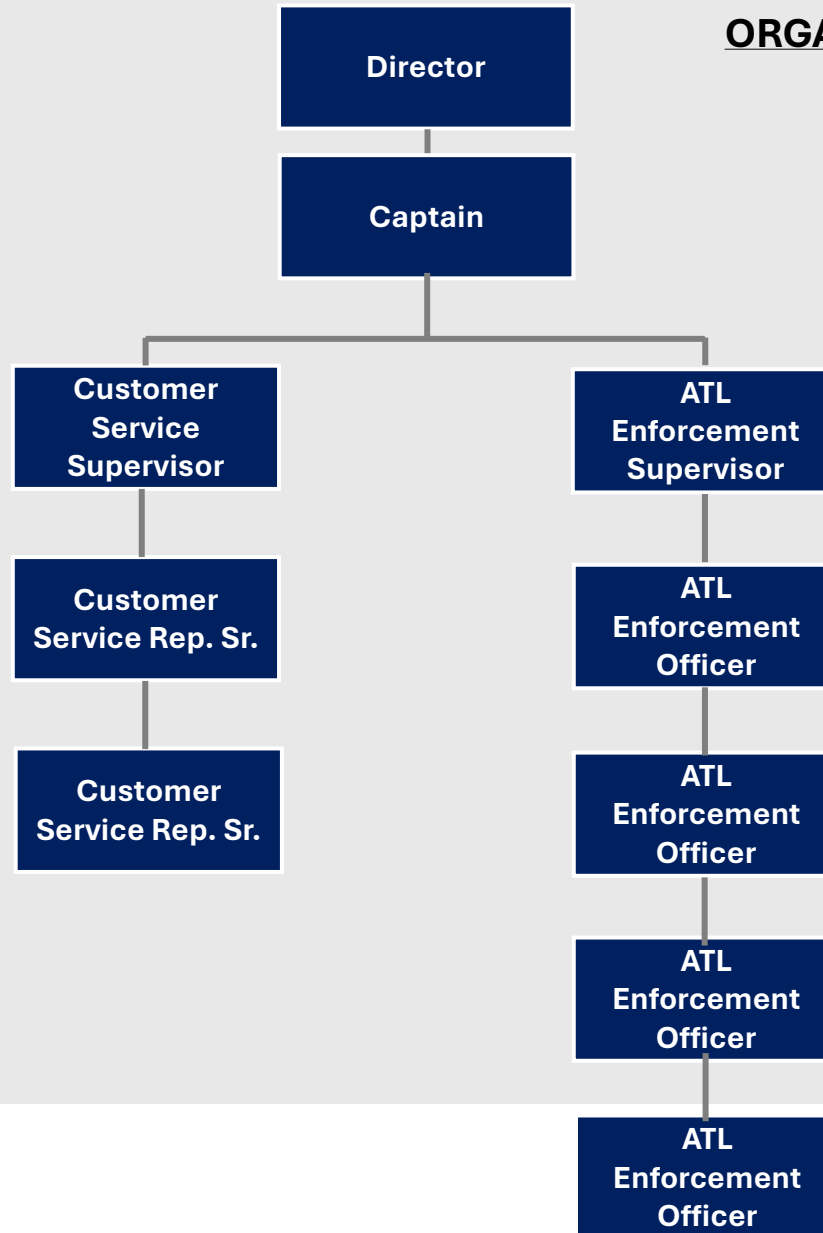
- There are CPNCs for 661 taxicabs and 22 equines
