# SAFE and SECURE HOUSING INITIATIVE

- Dedicated APD Code Enforcement team to inspect multifamily properties
- Team consists of a:
  - Project Manager
  - 3 Code Enforcement Officers
- Conducted 34 multifamily details since August 2022
  - Over 3,000 violations found
  - Over 1,000 violations complied
- Reduced time between re-inspection and court scheduling by 50%
- Monthly meeting with the Office of the City Solicitor to ensure efficiency

### **HISTORY**


- Customer Services Unit transferred to APD Code Enforcement Section in July 2022
- No enforcement activity under Section 162 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances in the downtown area since 2017
  - No random inspections of taxicabs and animal-drawn vehicles
  - Limited investigation of complaints filed by citizens and visitors
  - · Blatant violations of Section 162 missed

### **CURRENT**

- There are CPNCs for 661 taxicabs and 22 equines
- · Positions created
- SOP modified
- Training scheduled
