
SOLID WASTE SERVICES TONNAGE




TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SPECIAL OPS APRIL 2024 – JUNE 2024



Total SPECIAL OPS Cases Created vs % of Cases Resolved within SLA




OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024

STREET SWEEPING TOTAL TONNAGE & MILES APRIL 2024 – JUNE 2024










OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024









OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024







CUMULATIVE COA INTERNAL REPAIRS COMPLETED APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024




% - COA INTERNAL REPAIRS COMPLETED BY WEEK APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024


INTERNAL COA PENDING REPAIRS BY DEPARTMENT APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024





COMMERCIAL PENDING REPAIRS BY DEPARTMENT APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024



COMMERCIAL PENDING ACCIDENT REPAIRS BY DEPARTMENT APRIL 2024 - JUNE 2024



TOTAL HOURS SPENT MAINTAINING VEHICLES/EQUIPMENT BY DEPARTMENT (April 2024 - June 2024)


















DPW celebrates the life and will forever cherish the memory of DPW Environmental Service Worker Duria Bright who transitioned on June 9, 2024.
