






FY24 SPEND BY CATEGORY

Projects Executed Via Legislation from July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024 *Includes renewals, amendments, task orders, and change orders approved via the ELMS System






FY24 SOLICITATIONS WORKLOAD BY SOLICITATION TYPES



FY24 SOLICITATION TYPE DISTRIBUTION (171)








FY24 SOLICITATIONS WORKLOAD BY DEPARTMENTS










FY25 SOLICITATIONS WORKLOAD BY SOLICITATION TYPES





FY25 Q1 Solicitations By COA Departments (Percentage)












FY24 PURCHASE ORDERS

First Quarter PO Sum Total (Millions)




FY25 Number of POs Processed Per Day






FY24 SUPPLIER BUSINESS CLASSIFICATIONS



FY24 Newly Registered Suppliers with Business Classifications (123)






